FSA IDs/FAFSA: GVHS encourages ALL

seniors to create their FSA Ids, complete the FAFSA, and to narrow down their college admission options. In November, we will encourage students to complete their college applications. Information on the FSA Ids was also distributed to all seniors closer to the December window of the FAFSA opening for the Fall of 2024 students. ATECH students will receive an FSA Id session on their campus. (GV homebase seniors received FSA Id help the week of November 6th during 3A.) All seniors received the FSA ID steps document for how to create an account. Please reach out if you need assistance or see the ATECH ACCESS advisor for a one-on-one.

THE COMMON APP.

Consider completing just ONE college application for multiple colleges with the **Common App.** Directions, info, a list of colleges this will work for, etc. can all be found at https://www.commonapp.org/

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION: If you

fill out the Common App or a college application, please give the teachers a two+ week window to accommodate any recommendations they may need to complete. Also, please be sure to send them a courtesy email (or talk to them in person) explaining the impending task. :)

Anyone needing assistance with the FAFSA can schedule a one-on-one session with Lisa Jackson from Kent State Ashtabula's Financial Aid Office. You do not need to be attending Kent in order to receive the office's free assistance.

*FAFSA is experiencing some delays. Please plan accordingly when managing

scholarships and your final decisions on your college search.

Mrs. Brumit's google classroom code (**pgvvwec**) can help you with quick links to many junior and senior resources. Please check this out. It includes a senior checklist timeline, FAFSA info, SAR guidance, links to local colleges for post secondary options, info on applications & the Common APP, scholarships, O*NET, Shout outs, etc.

COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS: To participate in the CCP program, you need a letter of intent completed each year by April 1st for the following school year. The letter of intent is currently available for the 2024-2025 school year. Please be sure to complete one if you are considering participating in this program.

Mrs. Gibbons asks that you take care of any <u>dues</u> or class fees you may have. Feel free to contact her at

michelle.gibbons@grandvalley.school for an update on any fees owed. Diplomas cannot be issued if you do not pay your school fees and dues.

FEE WAIVERS: If you are on free/reduced lunch, you are eligible for a fee waiver for any college application. Please see your counselor for a fee waiver for the ACT or any colleges you apply to if you qualify for free/reduced lunch.

VOLUNTEER HOURS: Volunteer hours need to be turned into Mrs. Gibbons at the beginning of May for recognition at graduation. Students who secure 50 volunteer hours throughout high school will receive special honors at graduation. Students who secure 20 hours will earn the graduation seal for community service at GV. Please submit these hours as you complete them. We take a final count of community service forms at the start of May each school year.

ACT

The last day to register for the April 13, 2024 ACT test is March 8, 2024. Late registration is still available. End-of-Course Exams & Credit Detail

Please check to see if you have passed all the necessary assessments to graduate. You must acquire a 684+ on the ELA II and Algebra required end-of-course exams, earn 2 seals, as well as complete all required coursework. Seniors who have not secured the test scores needed for OPTION 1 graduation pathway will need to explore an alternative pathway according to the career, CCP, military, or ACT pathways available to you.
