## Smart Schools Bond Act Background

Enacted in 2015 state Budget, \$2 billion of bonds to be sold to fund Hi-Tech Projects in NYS Schools and Communities

Allowed projects are School and Community Connectivity, Classroom Learning Technology, High Tech Security and the phase out of Transportable Classrooms

30 Day comment period then 12-18 Month Approval Smart Schools Review Board

Applied in Dec 2018 for \$298,754 for Network and Wireless in conjunction with E-Rate Funds - Installed summer 2020

## Planning Process

- Begun in Spring 2023 looking at needs within district
- Only certain allowed expenses, Connectivity for School or Community, Classroom Learning, Pre-K Classrooms and Transportable Classrooms and Security
- Must line up with School Technology plan
- Worked with Administrators and Technology Committee to access needs

# **Project Selection**

- Identified replacement of network and wifi as biggest need
- Wireless network needs grow of access points to increase coverage and range
- Wireless network needs growth potential for Guest and BYOD Programs
- Wired Network endured construction and survived but needs replacement
- Goal #3 of District Technology Plan drives need
- Network and Wifi refresh are not budgeted for so one time money must be used

## Scope and Vendors

Existing switch quantity will suffice, schools physical set up hasn't changed

Need for 15 more Access points, need high availability for large areas and more small areas that are used for small office space, wifi is like oxygen must be available everywhere

Looking for 3 vendors/ bids and representation from 3 highest rate equipment manufacturers, Aruba, Cisco & Extreme (Gartner Reports)

Asked as many vendors as possible for proposals, but many had ceased operations in the area or didn't have the resources to respond
