Application Process

- 1. Applicant will complete application and essay electronically, attach school record, summary of volunteer experience, and send in one email to Counseling/Guidance Department with the subject title, "Fallen Heroes Application," by April 1st.
- 2. Applicant must meet eligibility requirements.
- 3. If multiple applications are received within a school district, the Counseling/Guidance Department will recommend the one applicant that best meets the below criteria and forward application and attachments to scholarships@nccfoundation.org, by April 15th. Only one application per school district will be reviewed by the Heroes Committee.
- 4. Of the applications received by the deadline, two (2) recipients will be selected.

Who is eligible to apply?

- I. Applicant must be graduating from one of the school districts within Chautauqua County.
- 2. Student must be pursuing higher education in one of the three areas:
 - a. Law Enforcement (including corrections officer),
 - b. Firefighting, or c. Emergency Medical Services

What are the criteria for selecting the recipients?

- I. Chances of success in chosen field
- 2. Essay (quality, appearance, and sincerity)
- 3. Volunteer service
- 4. School Record
