- 2. Students pursuing a CNA certification (Certified Nursing Assistant). Those pursuing an LPN (Licensed Practical Nurse) or paraprofessional certification may be considered.
- 3. Students planning a career working with the elderly or people in need of hands-on care.

- 3. Participation in formal or informal volunteer activities (school, church, club, community, home, family, etc.)


