#### **Application Process**

1. Student must meet eligibility requirements.

2. Student will complete application electronically, attach two letters of recommendation on forms provided, attach essay, attach Transcripts/grades, then send one email to Counseling/guidance Department with the subject title, "Centner 4-H Application," by April 1st.

## Who is Eligible to Apply?

- I. Graduating seniors from Brocton, Dunkirk, Forestville, Fredonia, Ripley, Silver Creek, or Westfield.
- 2. Participating members of the 4-H Program for 3 years with an outstanding agricultural or environmental project involving gardening, horticulture, raising food animals, conservation, forestry, environmental activities or other related projects.
- 3. Students accepted to a four-year college or university.

## What are the criteria for selecting the recipients?

- 1. Student(s) high school record, please attach Transcripts/grades.
- 2. Achievements in 4-H Program.
- 3. Prominence of the college or university attending.
- 4. Quality of essay entitled "What 4-H has meant to me as I embark on my collegiate studies."
- 5. Two letters of recommendation (one must have firsthand knowledge of students work in 4-H).
