

Dunkirk Fredonia Lions Club 2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Lions Club International is the world's largest service club organization with more than 1.4 million members in approximately 50 thousand clubs serving in more than 200 hundred countries and geographical areas around the world. Since 1917, Lions Clubs have aided the blind and visually impaired and embodied the motto: "We Serve." Lions clubs are committed to improving the world through community service and serving youth throughout the world. This commitment has, in part, led to the creation of the Dunkirk Fredonia Lions Club student scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

The scholarship is targeted to graduating seniors in our component districts who show potential of succeeding in furthering their education and who exhibit a commitment to serving others. There is available a \$500.00 scholarship for one senior from each of the eligible districts to help defray the cost of their continuing education. Please note that as "SERVICE" is a core value of Lions Club, a student's GPA is not the prime factor in deciding the award recipient and community service is heavily weighted.

REQUIREMENTS

- Student must be a graduating senior from Brocton High School, Dunkirk High School, Fredonia
 High School, Forestville High School, or Silver Creek High School.
- o Student must have a minimum 2.50 cumulative grade point average.
- o Student must show evidence of active participation in school and community activities/service.
- Student will be attending a postsecondary school: public/private college, university, or technical school, in either a two or four year program, or trade school program, starting no later than the fall semester following high school graduation
- O Student will submit application, attachments, essay, and parent/student authorization form

*NOTE: If selected, prior to receiving the award, the student will need to submit <u>proof of postsecondary enrollment</u>, a paid tuition receipt, and a schedule of classes for the upcoming semester. After receipt of same, a check will be sent. Submission deadline of January 15, 2025 or award will be forfeited.

ALL SCHOLARSHIP DECISIONS ARE AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE DUNKIRK FREDONIA LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP AWARD COMMITTEE.
