#### Late Arrivals and Early Pickup of Students

If your child is arriving late to school, please be sure to walk them up to the school and enter the front doors. Once inside, please press the call button located on the left hand wall to announce your arrival. You can call ahead of time to order their lunch if needed at: (248) 684-8190.

We receive many calls daily requesting that children be called to the office for early pick up. We are refraining from this procedure due to the volume of calls. If you need to pick up your child early, please come in to the building about 10 minutes before you need to leave the building and we will call the student down.

Be sure to bring your ID with you every time you come to the building, it is required due to our security process.

Please do not pick up your student after 3:45p.m. Our office staff is actively engaged in the dismissal process after that time.

# Family Access & More



- School begins at **9:15a.m.** and dismisses at **4:07 p.m.** Students are not to enter building to go to classrooms until **9:08a.m.** Please do not leave your child unattended before this time.
- A note must be sent to the office and teacher if any dismissal routines are different from the normal routine. Please make sure your child is aware of how they are going to get home after school or remind them of any dismissal arrangements **before** they leave for school in the morning.

We understand that emergencies arise and in that case we can get a note down to your child, or call your child to be picked up early. However, we do need to put a limit on classroom interruptions. Teachers are instructing until the end of the day and unnecessary early dismissals are not only interrupting the classroom, your child could be missing valuable information. Thank you for your understanding of this procedure.

#### **Contacting Heritage Staff**

When needing to reach a teacher or other staff member, emailing is one way to contact them regarding general information. If it is time sensitive or of an urgent matter, please feel free to call the office to leave a message for that person or be put through to their voice mail.



### **STEPS**

- 1. Go to the Huron Valley Schools website (www.hvs.org)
- 2. Click on Schools
- 3. Click on Heritage Elementary
- 4. Scroll down and click on the Criminal Record check box
- 5. Fill out and submit the google form (this is NOT the CRC)
- 6. An Email will be sent to you, from Droplet, that you must complete and submit.
- 7. A confirmation email will be sent to you when it is in process.
