
School Hours

Student and Teacher Messages

Just a reminder that calling the school to give a student a message should **only** be for last minute changes. Please send a note to the teacher with your child in the morning to let them know of plans for pick up, etc. when needed. Discuss the plans with your child as well. (Writing a note in their agenda is another great way to communicate with the teacher!) This helps avoid confusion for your child, as well as cutting down on the number of calls that the office receives during the day for messages. It also helps the teacher and office staff from making last minute calls to parents regarding the plan for the day. This often comes as students are being dismissed for buses, resulting in students missing their bus. Please be sure to **send a note anytime the plan is different from usual**. If your child normally rides a bus and they do not have a note saying otherwise, the student will be put on the bus. It is best to send in a note instead of emailing the teacher, in case they are absent. This way, the guest teacher will know the information. As always, if there is a last minute change or emergency, feel free to call the office to get your child a message. Thank you very much!
