Job Description

Title: Preschool Paraprofessional

Department(s): Instructional

Reports to: Teacher and/or Building Principal

Job Summary:

Assists in the instruction and implementation of developmentally appropriate educational opportunities and curriculum to preschool age children that develops the whole child (cognitive, social emotional, language/communication, and physical development) so that the overall district educational objectives may be achieved.

Summary of essential job function:

- 1. Conduct instructional activities assigned by the teacher; work with individual students or small groups for the purpose of practicing and/or reinforcing learning concepts and assisting students in reaching their academic goals and grade-level standards.
- 2. Implement, under the supervision of assigned teacher, instructional programs and lesson plans for the purpose of assisting the teacher in improving students' academic success through a defined course of study.
- 3. Help with setup, cleaning and sanitation of classroom supplies
- 4. Observe, react, and teach appropriate social interaction
- 5. Assist with student drop off and pick up
- 6. Provide recess supervision
- 7. Assist children in the restroom
- 8. Converse positively and appropriately with students
- 9. Assist with classroom management
- 10. Assist teacher with student's Individualized Education Program (IEP)
- 11. Assist teacher with parent engagement activities
- 12. Communicate positively and in a friendly manner with parents/guardians at pickup and drop off children
- 13. Work with early childhood special education teachers
- 14. Communicate to teacher any concerns or questions
- 15. Participate and attend staff meetings
- 16. Meet with classroom team members (Teachers, ECSE teachers)
- 17. Attend and help with open house before school begins for all families
- 18. Make sure accurate attendance is taken
- 19. Document referrals, fill out student injury reports as needed
- 20. Assist with snack times, as needed
- 21. Collect and maintain data as directed by the classroom teacher
- 22. Assist in classroom management.



- 23. Assist with the administration and scoring of objective testing instruments or work assignments.
- 24. Provide assistance to substitute teachers.
- 25. Function as an appropriate role model for children, providing proper examples, emotional support, and a friendly attitude and general guidance.
- 26. Demonstrate regular attendance and punctuality.
- 27. Adhere to the appropriate code of ethics and student confidentiality.
- 28. Respond to emergency situations for the purpose of resolving immediate safety concerns and/or directing to appropriate personnel for resolution.
- 29. Help supervise students throughout the school day, inside and outside the classroom. This includes lunchroom, bus and playground duty.
- 30. Keep teacher informed of individual students' needs.
- 31. Ensure compliance with annual training and certification requirements

Qualifications and Experience:

- High School diploma or equivalent required.
- Experience working with children, preferably in a learning environment.
- Ability to establish and maintain cooperative relationships with students, parents and staff.
- Strong oral and written communication skills; requires the ability to record and deliver information and explain procedures in a variety of technical and professional languages.
