The California High Road Training Partnership Grant has been thoughtfully designed to empower you to follow your dream of becoming a teacher. Participants are encouraged to meet the following criteria when applying for the program:

- Be employed as a paraprofessional in a California K-12 school district.
- Participants should have a minimum of 45 transferable credits.
- Must be able to start the program on or after April 1, 2024.
- Must be able to complete all program requirements and student teaching by March 31, 2026.
- The grant covers tuition and a \$9,000 stipend for student teaching (paid over 12 weeks).
