## **Superintendent Term Contract**

This Contract is entered into between the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of Bloomington Independent School District (the "District") and Eric Cormier (the "Superintendent").

The Board and the Superintendent, for and in consideration for the terms stated in this Contract, hereby agree as follows:

- 1. **Term.** The Board agrees to employ the Superintendent for a term of three (3) years, commencing on **July 05**, **2023** and ending **June 30**, **2026**. The Board and the Superintendent (the "Parties") may extend the term of this Contract by agreement.
- 2. **Certification.** The Superintendent agrees to maintain the required certification throughout the term of employment with the District. If the Superintendent's certification expires, is canceled, or is revoked, this Contract is void.
- 3. Representations. The Superintendent makes the following representations:
  - 3.1 **Beginning of Contract.** At the beginning of this Contract, and at any time during this Contract, the Superintendent specifically agrees to submit to a review of his national criminal history record information (NCHRI) if required by the District, TEA, or SBEC. The Superintendent understands that a criminal history record acceptable to the Board, at its sole discretion, is a condition precedent to this Contract.
  - 3.2 **During Contract.** The Superintendent also agrees that, during the term of this Contract, the Superintendent will notify the Board in writing of any arrest or of any indictment, conviction, no contest or guilty plea, or other adjudication of the Superintendent, except for Class C misdemeanors related to traffic violations. The Superintendent agrees to provide such notification in writing within seven calendar days of the event or any shorter period specified in Board policy.
  - 3.3 False Statements and Misrepresentations. The Superintendent represents that any records or information provided in connection with his employment application are true and correct. Any knowing or conscious false statements, misrepresentations, omissions of requested information, or fraud by the Superintendent in or concerning any required records or in the employment application may be grounds for termination or nonrenewal, as applicable.
- 4. **Duties.** The Superintendent shall be the educational leader and chief executive officer of the District. The Superintendent agrees to perform his duties as follows:
  - 4.1 Authority. The Superintendent shall perform such duties and have such powers as may be prescribed by the law and the Board. The Board shall have the right to assign additional duties to the Superintendent and to make changes in

- responsibilities or work at any time during the contract term. All changes in responsibilities or work and any duties assigned by the Board shall be appropriate to and consistent with the professional role and responsibility of the Superintendent.
- 4.2 Standard. Except as otherwise permitted by this Contract, the Superintendent agrees to devote his full time and energy to the performance of his duties. The Superintendent shall perform his duties with reasonable care, skill, and diligence. The Superintendent shall comply with all lawful Board directives, state and federal laws and rules, Board policy, and regulations as they exist or may hereafter be amended, including but not limited to Board policy DH (Exhibit) which is the Educators' Code of Ethics.
- 5. **Compensation.** The District shall pay the Superintendent an annual salary as follows:
  - 5.1 Salary. The District shall pay the Superintendent an annual salary of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars and No/Cents (\$120,000.00). The annual salary shall be paid to the Superintendent in equal monthly installments consistent with the Board's policies.
    - (a) Widespread Salary Reduction. If the Board implements a widespread salary reduction under Texas Education Code section 21.4032, the Superintendent's annual salary shall be reduced by the percent or fraction of a percent that is equal to the average percent or fraction of a percent by which teacher salaries have been reduced.
    - (b) Furlough. If the Board implements a furlough under Texas Education Code section 21.4021, the Superintendent shall be furloughed for the same number of days as other contract personnel and the Superintendent's salary shall be reduced in proportion to the number of furlough days.
  - 5.2 **Benefits.** The District shall provide benefits to the Superintendent as provided by state law and Board policies. The Board reserves the right to amend its policies at any time during the term of this Contract to reduce or increase those benefits provided to all District employees pursuant to Board policy, at the Board's sole discretion.
  - 5.3 Vacation, Holiday and Personal Leave. The Superintendent is entitled to the same number days of leave as authorized by Board policy for administrative employees on twelve-month contracts, and shall be entitled to the same holidays and breaks as provided for other twelve-month administrators in the Board's adopted calendar. The Superintendent shall be subject to the same schedule limitations on discretionary leave as set out in Board policy, except in extenuating circumstances as determined by the Board President. In addition, the Superintendent shall schedule leave days with prior written approval from Board President and at times that will least interfere with the performance of the Superintendent's duties.

- 5.4 **District Cell Phone.** The District shall provide the Superintendent with a cell phone that will solely be used for District business in his capacity as Superintendent with the account held in the District's name. This cell phone at all times is considered District property and the Superintendent shall have no expectation of privacy while operating this device. The Superintendent shall comply with all District technology policies, procedures, and protocols relating to his use of this District cell phone. To the extent the Superintendent resigns, retires, is placed on paid or unpaid administrative leave, or is terminated, the Superintendent must immediately return the District cell phone to the District.
- 5.5 **Transportation.** The District shall make a District vehicle reasonably available to the Superintendent for out of district travel. Nothing within this agreement precludes the Superintendent from requesting and the Board from approving transportation expenses when deemed appropriate and requested and approved in writing.
- 5.6 Relocation/Moving Expenses. The District shall reimburse the Superintendent for reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in moving and relocating the Superintendent's family and personal possessions to Victoria County, Texas, up to a maximum of Two Thousand Dollars and No/Cents (\$2,000.00). The Superintendent shall document all such expenses with receipts, canceled checks or credit card statements.
- 5.7 Civic Activities. The Board encourages the Superintendent to become a member of and participate in community and civic affairs, including the chamber of commerce, civic clubs, governmental committees, and educational organizations. The Board concludes that such participation will serve a legitimate purpose related to the educational mission of the District. The expenses related to membership in all local civic organizations in which the Superintendent participates and related travel outside of the District, may be borne by the District subject to advance Board approval.
- 5.8 **Professional Organizations.** The Superintendent shall devote the Superintendent's time, attention, and energy to the direction, administration, and supervision of the District. The Board, however, encourages the continued professional growth of the Superintendent through the Superintendent's active attendance and participation in appropriate professional meetings, seminars, conferences, or courses at the local, regional, state, and national level. In its encouragement of the Superintendent to grow professionally, the Board shall permit a reasonable amount of release time for the Superintendent as the Superintendent and the Board deem appropriate, to attend such meetings, seminars, conferences, or courses. The District does hereby agree to provide in the District's budget per contract year an amount to be used for registration, travel, meals, lodging, and other related expenses. The District shall pay for the Superintendent's membership dues to the Texas Association of School Administrators and one other professional organization selected by the Superintendent and the District shall bear the reasonable cost and other related

expenses for such attendance and membership.

- 5.9 **District Housing.** As a condition of employment with the Bloomington Independent School District, except as provided below, the Superintendent shall reside in the District owned residence at 103 Pearl Street, Placedo, Texas 77977 at all times while employed by the District, unless otherwise decided by the Board. The Superintendent shall be subject to all of the terms and conditions addressed in the Bloomington Independent School District Employee Housing Agreement, incorporated herein, relating to his occupancy of the residence.
- 6. **Suspension.** In accordance with Texas Education Code chapter 21, the Board may suspend the Superintendent without pay during the term of this Contract for good cause as determined by the Board.
- 7. **Termination and Nonrenewal of Contract.** Termination or nonrenewal of this contract, or resignation under this contract, will be pursuant to Texas Education Code chapter 21.
- 8. General Provisions.
  - 8.1 Amendment. This Contract may not be amended except by written agreement of the Parties.
  - 8.2 **Severability.** If any provision in this Contract is, for any reason, held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of the Contract. This Contract shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been a part of the Contract.
  - 8.3 **Entire Agreement.** All existing agreements and contracts, both verbal and written, between the Parties regarding the employment of the Superintendent are superseded by this Contract. This Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties.
  - 8.4 **Applicable Law and Venue.** Texas law shall govern construction of this Contract. The Parties agree that venue for any litigation relating to the Superintendent's employment with the District, including this Contract, shall be the county in which the District's administration building is located. If litigation is brought in federal court, the Parties agree that venue shall be the federal district and division in which the district's administration building is located.
  - 8.5 **Paragraph Headings.** The headings used at the beginning of each numbered paragraph in this Contract are not intended to have any legal effect; the headings do not limit or expand the meaning of the paragraphs that follow them.
  - 8.6 **Legal Representation.** Both Parties have been represented by legal counsel of their choice, or have had the opportunity to consult with legal counsel, in the negotiation and execution of this Contract.

## 9. Notices.

- 9.1 To Superintendent. The Superintendent agrees to keep a current address on file with the District's human resources office and the Board President. The Superintendent agrees that the Board may meet any legal obligation it has to give the Superintendent written notice regarding this Contract or the Superintendent's employment by hand-delivery, or by certified mail, regular mail, and/or express delivery service to the Superintendent's address of record.
- 9.2 To Board. The Board agrees that the Superintendent may meet any legal obligation to give the Board written notice regarding this Contract or the Superintendent's employment by providing one copy of the notice to the President of the Board and one copy to the Vice President of the Board. The Superintendent may provide such notices by hand delivery, or by certified mail, regular mail, and/or express delivery service, to the Board President and Vice President's addresses of record, as provided to the District.
