Citizens Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) Fifth Annual Report (FY 2022-2023)

December 13, 2023

Measure X Background: On November 6, 2018, the voters of the San Bruno Park School District (SBPSD) authorized Measure X for the sale of \$79,000,000 in General Obligation Bonds. The proceeds of the Bonds are intended to be used to upgrade classrooms, science labs, technology, and school facilities to support student achievement and college readiness, improve student and school safety/security and repair deteriorating roofs, plumbing and electrical systems. Measure X received a favorable vote of approximately 70% with high voter turnout.

Ms. Lee completed her first three-year term in June 2023 and was approved by the Board to continue with a second three-year term. Brent Pliskow resigned from the CBOC in March 2023 due to his family moving out of state. Hence, the CBOC began with six members at the start of the fiscal year (July 2022) and after Brent's resignation, had five members.

The CBOC has three vacancies as of 3/11/2023 for the following citizen representatives:

- 1. One (1) Active in a business organization representing the business community located in the District.
- 2. One (1) Active in a senior citizen's organization.
- 3. One (1) Community at Large.

Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee Purpose & Duties: The Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC)'s purpose and duties are to inform the public concerning the District's expenditures of Measure X bond proceeds; review Measure X expenditures to ensure bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measure X; and present to the Board of Trustees, in public session, an annual compliance report.

Completed Proceedings & Activities: The Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee had seven (7) committee meetings during this Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-23 annual report period, to receive, inquire, discuss and review information pertaining to the bond expenditures and projects, to conduct site visits and discuss and approve the previous fiscal year's annual report. Measure X Bond Expenditures: From July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 (i.e., Fiscal Year 2022/23), Measure X bond expenditures were \$13,755,252.82. Table 1 shows a summary report of Measure X expenditures by project. Table 2 shows a summary report of Measure X expenditures by expense type. Cumulative Measure X bond expenditures through June 30, 2023, were \$45,681,913.16 and summaries of previous fiscal years' expenditures can be found in previous CBOC Annual Reports.

Allen Elementary School Project

In August 2022, Phase 1 of the Allen Elementary School project was complete including the Multi-Use Room, Kindergarten, 2-story Classroom and the Administration building.
