Did You Know?

- If you want to drop off your child without getting out of your car, Madison Street (north side of school) is designated for that.
- If you want to walk your child to the door, please use the main parking lot (south side of the building)
- If you want to drop off your child but still wish to use the main parking lot, follow the steps below.

AM Main Door Drop Off:

Students are only to be dropped off by the sidewalk (first row). Please do not allow students to walk across the parking lot unattended.

Our crossing guards limit the amount of cars in the front drop off line to let students out. Parents who let students off in this lane are asked to remain in their car to keep the line moving.

Please make sure your child has their coat on/ bag packed and ready to exit the car when it is their turn to do so. This really helps keep the line flowing.

PM Main Door Pick Up:

Please park your car in a designated space and walk to the main entrance to pick up your child.

Please do not drive up and have students hop in the vehicles. This creates lots of congestion in the front row and is not a safe situation for students and parents who have parked/exited their car and are waiting to pick up their child.

We ask that parents waiting to pick up their child remain on the concrete/sidewalk areas and out of the main parking lot area.

Madison Street (North) entrance is dedicated for quick student drop off and pick up with parents remaining in vehicles at all times.
