Report Absences

In the event of your child having to miss school, it is important that you report your child off to the ATA Attendance line by calling the school at 304-387-1915 **[Press 7 for attendance]** before 8:30. You are welcome to send a Dojo message to your child's teacher, but the absence must be recorded on the Attendance line for proper documentation. HCS Policy states "Students are allowed ten (10) parental excused days each year. These are days where a visit to the doctor is not necessary, but the child is ill or absent for another reason. If your child is absent more than ten (10) parental excused days, all further absences will be considered unexcused unless a doctor's note is provided. If your child's absence is due to a doctor's appointment due to an illness or a wellness visit, please send in the doctor's "return to school" form so the absence(s) will be counted as medically excused."

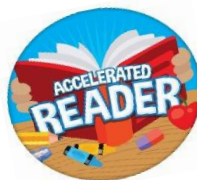
