
10th Street Middle School

10th Street has been an option program in the Marysville School District since 1995. This year, we are happy to announce that we are starting a new path of the school with the same educational model. We will start by bringing in an additional 6th Grade class this year, with a three-year plan to expand the program to include all three grades of 6th, 7th, and 8th.

Each Pathway will have the following features:

- Parents must submit a transfer request for their preferred pathway.
- Electives are pre-determined based on the selected pathway.
- We use a lottery system to select the students for our pathways.
- ❖ We believe relationships are important to learning and strive to keep the students with the same teachers through all three grade levels, 6th, 7th, and 8th.
- ❖ We feature a core curriculum that requires three years of music and visual creativity, and physical education. In year 2 or 3, Spanish will be introduced into the model.
- ❖ At 10th Street, we ask our students to live by a code of conduct that encourages Respectful, Responsible and Ready (the 3-R's) behavior.
- Students can still participate in athletics through their home middle school.
- District Transportation is provided.
- We believe if we set high standards and provide educational supports, students will achieve those high standards.
- ❖ We provide push-in IEP support with scaffolding through our Student Support room.
- ❖ We offer high school credited courses to all 8th graders.
- ❖ We work to create life-long learners by prioritizing reading, field trips that connect to their academics, and using mediation as the primary method of dealing with behavior.

How will pathways differ?

- The original 10th will feature Band as their music course. The new pathway will feature Choir.
- Each student must decide their pathway at the time of the Transfer period. To switch pathways after the Transfer period will require another transfer request and the waitlist protocols will be applied.
