Meet Our Heart Hero, Corbin!

Corbin 5th grader at Grove

Corbin was born with Hypoplastic Right Heart Syndrome, requiring three open heart surgeries before the age of 5. While some do well with those surgeries, others like Corbin require additional interventions. Ultimately, Corbin received a heart transplant at the age of 5. He suffered additional severe injuries to his lungs, vocal cords and kidneys along with rejection and infections after transplant. He had to relearn how to walk, eat and talk again, and continues to work hard every day to maintain his health. One day he hopes to meet his donor's family and he continues to be a good steward of their heart by taking full responsibility to take his life saving medications daily. He has been in choir for three years as well as Krav Maga and Martial Arts for two years. He hopes to become a nurse practitioner or doctor someday.
