

Marysville Getchell High School Senior Yearbook Photo Requirements

It is **not** required to have a professional take your senior portrait. We will have Dorian take school pictures at the beginning of the school year that can be used in our Yearbook. You are required to have your photo taken by the school photographer. If you do not submit a photo, or your submitted photo does not meet the outlined specifications below, the photo taken at the beginning of the year by the school photographer will be used.

Photo Specificaations Senior Photo's submitted to the yearbook bust be:

- Head shots ONLY... No props, hats, hoods, pets, etc in photo
- Must be in color
- Minimum 2.25" wide, 3" height, and 300 dpi preferred
- Indoor, with a solid color background is suggested
- Cropped photo's do not always size properly so please do not submit cropped photos.

Note:

- Do not cut the head, hairline at the top of the photo
- Outdoor backgrounds can be used but not suggested.
- Only head and shoulders will be in the yearbook photo.

Digital File Format

- 300 Dpi
- Width 2.25"
- Height 3"
- File format type JPEG or JPG

DO NOT SUBMIT PHOTOS IN WORD, DOCS, GIF OR PDF file formats.

WE DO NOT ENCOURAGE TAKING PRINTS FROM YOUR PHOTOGRAPHER AND SCANNING THEM. THE QUALITY IS USUALLY POOR. HAVE YOUR PHOTOGRAPHER SUBMIT THE IMAGE TO US.

Submission Process

All images MUST BE submitted electronically via email. We will not accept hard copy prints. Please attach to an email your photo with your students name to: <u>mg-senior-photos@msvl.k12.wa.us</u>
