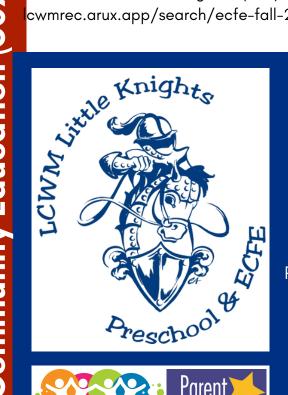
ECFE recognizes that families provide children their first and most important learning environment and that parents are their children's first and most significant teachers. Classes hosted by ECFE will meet in Fall, Winter, and Spring. You are welcome to join us for any number of terms, and registration will occur prior to the start of each term. Classes with low enrollment will be cancelled. No refunds will be given unless the class you've registered for is cancelled. Scholarships are available. Register online, over the phone at (507) 726-2673, or in person Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Early Childhood Screening:

Screening is a free and simple check of how your child is doing at age 3-4 years. During the screening, well-qualified staff will check your child's vision, hearing, growth, immunization status, skills in thinking, communication and language, large and small motor skills and social/emotional development. The screening is free of charge and children are **required** to have had an early childhood screening done prior to entering kindergarten.

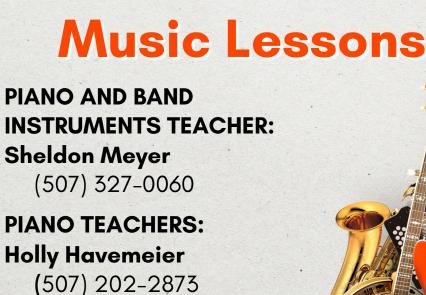

Student Requirements:

- 100 hours of community service per year. Half of those hours (50) must be with the same entity/organization.
- Two recommendations from agencies or individuals served that describe the volunteer work completed and the student's attitude and competence.
- A digital photo of them doing service or a photo that represents their service experience.
- Reflection paper this is an opportunity for students to reflect on their service and share their service experience with others.
- Chemical Free students will be chemicalfree and verify that to be true on the application.

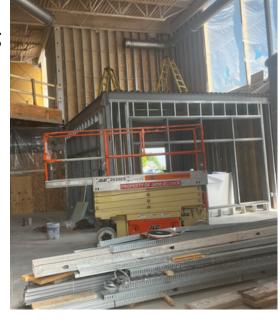
