- a. Update on school improvement goals from last year. Our Milestone Math scores are in. Have not had time to dig into the data but forthcoming. Mr. Lowrance and Dr. Owen met with assistant superintendent Sket Angland to discuss data results for AMS. They discussed strategies that will be used to grow students across the board.
