Provide safety in the classroom

Assist in the implementation of individual educational plans

Assist in tutorial activities working with individuals or small groups of students.

Assist students in the development of communication skills and serve as an appropriate language model.

Assist with routine classroom procedures, supervise opening exercises, cleanup activities, attendance, and collect materials

Collect, classify, and file materials for use in providing an appropriate learning environment. Supervise play area, cafeteria and field trip activities

Perform routine first aid and seek assistance for non-routine illness and injuries.

Assist with the arrangement and storage of classroom facilities including displays, bulletin boards, furniture, and accessories.

May assist with individualized car for students who require individualized services at school such as catheterizations, NG Feeding Tube, and medications, etc.

Assists in toileting and/or bathroom assistance.

Assists students to shape appropriate social behavior, provide physical development and "self care," and positions/locates students to avoid abusive behavior.

Teach students individually and in small groups to reinforce instructional materials, improve "self care", and to learn new skills and abilities
