The monies for our scholarship fund are raised through our yearly Legacy Motorcycle Run held in September to honor those that made the ultimate sacrifice for our country and for those who continue to protect our freedoms.

The eligibility requirements for consideration of an American Legion Riders Post 259 Veterans Scholarship are as follows:

- 1. An applicant must be a legal child of a post-September 11, 2001, active-duty service member, or veteran
- 2. An applicant must reside in Otsego, Delaware, or Chenango County
- 3. An applicant must be a high school senior or high school graduate to apply for the scholarship.
- 4. An applicant must be considered of good moral character.

We are so proud to be able to raise these funds to help our local students. We hope you will share this opportunity with your upcoming graduates.
