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Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Concord High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2023-24 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was identified as having not been given one of these labels.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

Concord High School is the only high school in the Concord Community School District that services students in grades 9 through 12. Any parent/guardian new to the district wishing to enroll their child in the school must complete the registration process in person during our regular office hours. Ninth-grade students are automatically enrolled at Concord High School if they were current CCS students after eighth grade.

THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Concord High School maintains a 3-5 year school improvement plan with goals for Math and Reading proficiency, family engagement, and strategies to develop and recognize increasing capacity in leaders and teachers. Student achievement data was used with the district to determine strategy in Math and Reading and School Connectedness. A primary focus of the plan includes the delivery of support programs for Special Education and other at-risk students, maximizing student access to instruction. Best practice instructional strategies and targeted intervention strategies in each area remain an emphasis during staff professional development.

A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL

Concord High School is a traditional grade 9-12 school, there are no specialized schools.

HOW TO ACCESS A COPY OF THE CORE CURRICULUM

Concord High School is currently working to align our curriculum. Through Horizontal teaming, staff continue to collaborate to align standards across grade levels, calibrate learning expectations, and establish essential skills. 2023-2024 dual enrollment participation included two students 1%.

Advanced Placement (AP) courses 2023-2023

Concord High School offers a total of five different advanced placement courses. The courses are as follows: AP Computer Science Principles, AP Computer Science, AP English Literature and Composition, AP Language and Composition, and AP Chemistry.

No Students were able to achieve a score that would award college credit for the completion of the AP exam.
