- 1. The Building Leadership Team (BLT) will work together to create a lasting, clear and simple framework to ensure high levels of learning for all. Team members will be compensated for bi-monthly meetings held outside of contract hours. Meetings will include discussions focused on student mastery of essential standards. Blake Clark will conduct Solution Tree training for all faculty members. (Culture of Collaboration)
- 2. East Elementary promotes school safety and good behavior through positive behavioral interventions and supports (PBIS). Additional staff will be hired to support PBIS in the school with a focus on prevention and teaching behavior expectations and strategies. (Social Emotional Learning)
- 3. Academic learning will be further developed by implementing 21st century skills through the use of blended learning tools, iReady Reading & Math licenses, Amplify, iPads, and other technology related tools. Additional staff and supplies and materials will be purchased to support this goal. (Future Ready Education)

Trust Land Goal: East Elementary will increase student proficiency in reading fluency and accuracy by 5% in grades 1-5. Kindergarten will increase proficiency in Nonsense Word Fluency (NWF) - Correct Letter Sounds (CLS) by 5%. East Elementary will hire a 25.5 hour literacy aide to work with students deemed at-risk and placed within our multi-tiered system of literacy support.

Describe how each SMART goal will be measured.

- 1. Grade level teams will identify essential standards and focus on them during weekly PLC meetings. They will create and post a poster to track team progress. Progress monitoring will be conducted with each student monthly. Student academic success will be measured using Acadience Reading and Math benchmarks and progress monitoring. RISE scores will also be used as a measurement of overall progress. (Culture of Collaboration)
- 2. Student behavior will be tracked using Educator's Handbook. Additional behavior data will be taken by the Wellness Center and administrative consequences. Behavior data will be discussed monthly during PBIS meetings to make adjustments to the PBIS system as needed. (Social Emotional Learning)
- 3. Student academic growth will be measured through the use of various assessment tools, including: RISE scale scores, DIBELS Acadience Reading assessments, progress monitoring, and iReady Reading Diagnostic assessments. Our school reading goal is to see a 5% increase in reading fluency and accuracy in grades 1-5 and in NWF-CLS for Kindergarten. Our school math goal is to have 50% of all students proficient in Acadience Math Computation. (Future Ready Education)
