

64% proficient to 66%. North elementary grew by 2% on Acadience Reading. We me this goal. Largely this was a result of our plan and funding aides for our tier 2 interventions in reading.

On the RISE we improved from 2020/2021 to 2021-2022 in ELA 42.6% to 48.3%, Math 48.3% to 54%, and Science 51.2% to 53.6%, surpassing our 2% improvement goal.

This is the Action Plan Steps identified in the plan to reach the goal.

- 1. Instructional interventions will be provided by aides for reading, science, and/or math.
- 2. We will provide books to students to take home each night from our 'take-home library.'
- 3. We will provide additional instruction during teacher prep time. Teachers and aides will teach students in STEM subjects and/or art.
- 4. We will provide enrichment activities in STEAM subjects during lunch and after school.
