

## **Helmville Community Club Memorial Scholarship Requirements**

**A scholarship will be awarded to each qualified applicant for his or her FIRST year of postsecondary education in an accredited college, university or technical school. This is to include students who may postpone initial enrollment after high school.**

### **Eligibility requirements:**

1. The candidate has demonstrated an exceptional commitment to the Helmville community by being active and participating in various events such as:
  - a. rodeo concessions, parking, cleanup
  - b. craft bazaar
  - c. community clean-up/upkeep
  - d. 4-H community service
  - e. basketball concessions and cleanup for grade school games and the men's tournament
  - f. horse poker run
  - g. Father Mac concession
  - h. maintenance and upkeep of ballfield
  - i. school grounds upkeep
  - j. St Thomas Cemetery spring cleanup and other help throughout the season
  - k. housebound or elderly care
2. The candidate must be a resident within the Helmville Fire District **OR** a graduate of Helmville Grade School. This is to include residents in the Helmville Fire District who have children that are home schooled or may attend another area grade school.
3. The candidate must be a member of the HCC with a High School Membership.
