- 1. Statewide testing accommodations must be in place 30 days prior to the start of testing.
- February Child Count All annual IEPs due on or <u>before</u> February 1, 2024 need to be completed and turned in to the IEP Facilitator by *January* 19, 2024

LEAP Connect/Alternate Assessment (Former LAA1)

Any amendments for LEAP Connect accommodations must be completed and submitted to the IEP Facilitator by <u>December 15, 2023</u>. **No exceptions.** The state deadline for changes is during Christmas break. Therefore, we must have them submitted prior to the holidays. Note: If the IEP team is considering changing a student from taking regular state assessment (LEAP) to alternate assessment (LEAP Connect), a SPED Program Coordinator MUST be contacted for consultation. There is specific eligibility criterion that must be met in accordance with Louisiana Bulletin 1530. If a student participates in alternate assessment and does not meet the criteria, the school will receive a zero.

LEAP Regular Assessment

If you have a student participating in regular state assessment (LEAP) and changes to accommodations are needed, you must contact the IEP Facilitator to request an IEP Amendment. Information needed for the request: Student's SER ID#, initials and the reason for the accommodation amendment. Deadline to request an IEP Amendment for LEAP 2025 accommodations is <u>January 26, 2024</u>. <u>There will be</u>

no accommodation amendments for grades 3 – 12 made after February 2, 2024. *

Note: The school test coordinator may request copies of IEP accommodations for LEAP testing. Teachers should provide accommodations from the most recent IEP in SER. For example, if you provide a copy of MN's IEP accommodations (dated 12/7/21) to the test coordinator in February 2022; Then, the IEP team meets again on 3/10/22 - You must give a copy of the NEW IEP accommodations (dated 3/10/22) to the school test coordinator. ^{*}The only exceptions will be for students who move in from out of district and they will be reviewed on a case-bycase basis.
