INSTRUCTION

6:190 Extracurricular and Co-Curricular Activities

The Superintendent must approve an activity in order for it to be considered a District-sponsored extracurricular or co-curricular activity, using the following criteria:

- 1. The activity will contribute to the leadership abilities, social well-being, self-realization, good citizenship, or general growth of student-participants.
- 2. Fees assessed students are reasonable and do not exceed the actual cost of operation.
- 3. The District has sufficient financial resources for the activity.
- 4. Requests from students.
- 5. The activity will be supervised by a school-approved sponsor.

Academic Criteria for Participation

For students in 5th through 8th grade, participants must meet the age requirements of the I.E.S.A. to be eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics.

Any student participating in any extra-curricular activities (excluding intramural) shall be eligible to participate if the student maintains a 1.5 grade average in all subjects based on a grading scale of 4 for an A, and 1 for a D. Any student having an "F" for an average in any subject at the end of any week will be ineligible to participate the following week. Any student receiving an "F" for a nine weeks average will be ineligible for a minimum of three weeks and until the "F" is corrected. Any exceptions to this will be left up to the discretion of the Superintendent with Board approval.
