Forms and Bus Fee due by 01/31/2024

We can only take the first 90 riders who turn in their bus fee.

Bus Fee: \$90.00 Make Check out to BHS Winter Ride

Lessons: REQUIRED for all new participants.

Lessons / Mountain Skills **\$99.00 plus tax**
4 lessons (2 hours each 9-11am)

Rentals: (ski or snowboard, helmets included): **\$127.78 plus tax**

Winter Ride Onward Pass: (Optional) This pass allows straight-to-chairlift access to the ski area any day of operation from March 2nd through the end of the 2024 season. Each participant must have an onward pass, season pass or a daily lift ticket each day of participation.

Age	WR Onward Pass March – end of season
11 - 15	\$164.81 plus tax
16 - 18	\$254.63 plus tax

Important Steps to Register:

1. Complete the Blaine permission slip and send payment for the bus to the Blaine High School Office made out to BHS WINTER RIDE to secure your spot. This fee will NOT be refunded after March 1st.
2. Then sign up for the Winter Ride Program at <https://www.mtbaker.us/lessons-rentals/multi-week-lessons/winter-ride/>
3. After signing up for the Winter Ride Program, it is important to sign up on the **Remind App** to receive text notifications on cancellations and when we will be arriving back home from the mountain. (Cancellations have happened the morning of the event due to inclement weather)
