

### Thank you for your interest in the Abbeville Mayor's Youth Council!

The Abbeville Mayors' Youth Council (AMYC) was formed in 2024, and is a coalition of students dedicated to representing the youth of Vermilion Parish. This program is open to students in grades 8–12 who live or attend a school within the parish. As a Youth Council member, you will represent your peers, learn about local government, and engage in community service and leadership opportunities.

Before applying to become a member, please read the below and attached tentative schedule so you understand the attendance and service requirements.

Meetings are typically held during the second week of each month starting in October. They are generally held at Abbeville City Hall, unless otherwise noted in the program schedule.

Through meetings, members may hear from leaders in various roles of municipal government, local businesses and non-profit organizations, to learn about leadership qualities and the importance of community service.

Volunteering at city sponsored events is part of AMYC, through events members gain knowledge of what goes into the event as well as have an opportunity to serve the community.

#### Requirements

Members are expected to attend two-thirds of all monthly Youth Council meetings, at least one regular Abbeville City Council meeting, and actively volunteer at city-sponsored events.

Absences will only be excused in the case of school-related functions (with prior notice), personal illness, or family emergencies. Members must communicate all absences directly with the AMYC Coordinator in advance, either by email or through the Remind app
