

FRANKLINTON HIGH SCHOOL STADIUM RULES

- 1. Franklinton High School is a drug free zone. Drugs, alcohol, and firearms are prohibited. Anyone in possession of the above mentioned is subject to arrest.
- 2. FHS has a clear bag policy and metal detectors in use.
- 3. FHS is a non-smoking facility.
- 4. No outside food or drink allowed in the stadium.
- 5. Visiting fans must enter at the visitor gate.
- 6. Fans must pay to re-enter.
- 7. Fans are not allowed to stand or sit along the fence. Everyone should be in the stands.
- 8. No one is allowed to cross the field. Restrooms and concessions are available on the visitor side.
- 9. No one is allowed on the field after the game until the home team breaks the huddle.
- 10. We expect both schools to exhibit sportsmanship throughout the event and act in an orderly fashion.
