Duties/Responsibilities

- 1. Prepares and implements lessons for Career Education Courses in accordance with the PCHS Program of Studies
- 2. Develops and maintains a classroom environment conducive to effective learning within the limits of the resources provided by the District
- 3. Strives to implement by instruction and action the District's mission and belief statements
- 4. Evaluates student progress on a regular basis
- 5. Develops academic and behavioral expectations for students' participation in work-based learning opportunities, including handbooks and permission forms
- 6. Coordinates supervision and evaluation of students in career-based courses and training sites
- 7. Collaborates with the Principal, Guidance Counselor, and other appropriate personnel to develop schedules for student work experiences
- 8. Coordinates with PCHS and PCJH teachers to schedule career-focused activities, including but not limited to, guest speakers and job shadowing
- Establishes relationships with regional businesses and organizations to expand career education placement opportunities for students
- 10. Serves on local workforce development boards and organizations
- 11. Prepares and submits reports as requested by Administration and/or as required by State or other organizations
- 12. Assists the Guidance Counselor with development and implementation of the PaCE Framework, including articulation with PCJH
- 13. Participates in curriculum development programs
- 14. Leads the development of an annual career and college fair
- 15. Attends CTE conferences and workshops
- 16. Promotes career awareness and opportunities and its role in the high school to internal and external stakeholders
- 17. Works with supervisors to develop and maintain programs and environments that promote the safety and welfare of students, faculty, staff, and visitors
- 18. Follows all policies and procedures as approved by the Board of Education and administration
- 19. Perform related duties as assigned for all PC #535 schools
