

LAREDO ISD: Student Use of Personal Communication Device Policy (Cell Phones, Smart Watches, Tablets & More)

Devices Are Not Allowed to Be Used During the School Day

To support learning and minimize distractions, **students are not allowed to use any personal communication devices** — including cell phones, smart watches, tablets, and other electronic devices — during school hours.

School Hours: From the **first bell to the last bell** on all school property (classrooms, hallways, gyms, cafeterias, restrooms, outdoor areas, parking lots, etc.)

What Is Allowed

- Possession is allowed, however devices must be powered off and stored inside backpacks at all times during the school day.
- Use is allowed after the school day ends.

Examples of Prohibited Devices

- Cell phones
- Smart watches
- Tablets
- Any other electronic device capable of telecommunication or digital communication

Consequences for Violating the Policy

1st Offense:

- Device confiscated and stored in office
- Parent/guardian is notified
- Warning issued
- Device can only be picked up by a parent/guardian

2nd Offense:

- Device confiscated and stored
- Parent/guardian is notified
- 1 day of In-School Suspension (ISS)
- Device released to parent/guardian only

3rd Offense or More:

- Device confiscated and stored
- In-person meeting required with parent, student, and principal before device is returned
- 2–3 days ISS
- Additional disciplinary actions may apply

If not retrieved: Devices not picked up within 90 days after final notice may be disposed of.

During State Testing

- Students may NOT carry or access any electronic device
- Devices must be turned in to the test administrator
- State assessments may be invalidated if a device is found in use or possession

Exceptions May Apply

Some students may be authorized to use devices under the following circumstances:

- As part of an IEP or 504 plan
- With medical documentation from a licensed Texas physician
- As required by state law or district emergency protocols

Each exception must be documented with the campus principal. Students may still face consequences for using devices outside the approved use.

Important Reminders

- Students are not allowed to access devices during the day
- Staff will confiscate any visible or active device use
- Schools are not responsible for lost or stolen items
- Parents/Guardians will be notified within 2 days of confiscation
