Renaissance High School was established in 2009 as a school of choice for students who live in the boundary area of West Ada School District. It is a four-year high school which offers an honor, accelerated choice for students interested in a college prep curriculum. During the junior and senior year, a student will have the option of enrolling in the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program, Career Program, or an Associate Degree Program. Renaissance High School has 210 available spots for each grade level which are chosen through a lottery process.
