Grade 7-12

- Amira Al reading fluency tutor for below level readers and Freckle for proficient or advanced readers. These tools will be utilized 3
 days/week for 10-15 minutes during English instruction. These tools will also be used 2 days/week for both 7th and 8th grade students.
- HD Word from Really Great Reading 2-3 days/week during 3rd hour with Mrs. Bohnenstingl.
- Grades 9-12 will have targeted 1-1 support to assist in classroom assignments and will also have the resource room available for students that need additional support.
- Ms. Berg and her students have access to pilot programs for fact fluency. They are determining which program is best for practice and retention.
- Aleks Math, a research based online math platform that provides individualized support on all concepts of math, will also be piloted.
