Graduation Requirements

The graduation requirements set out in this policy will apply to the Class of 2013. Students who will be in the ninth (9th) grade for the 2009-10 must adjust their schedules for each school year beginning 2009-10 to satisfy the minimum requirements for high school graduation in 2013.

The minimum graduation requirements effective for the Class of 2013 are as follows:

The District will accept courses offered through Missouri's K12 Virtual Instructional Program (MoVIP) as units of credit meeting state and local graduation requirements beginning with the 2007-08 school year provided however the quantity and quality of completed student works meets standards applicable to the District's traditional program. (See Policy Virtual Instruction Program).

Students transferring with unaccredited status to the South Holt District will be required to be in attendance (at South Holt R-1) a minimum of six (6) consecutive semesters of high school in order to be considered for valedictorian/salutatorian awards or top ten percent of class honors.
