- The Dynamic Learning Map (DLM) is designed for students who are unable to take the NJSLA due to cognitive disabilities.
- The DLM is an alternative assessment that assesses students in the areas of math, language arts, and science.
- Since the district administered the test to less than 10 students, the results are not made public to protect the student's anonymity.

Next Steps

- Conduct data team meetings with our grade level teams to review the evidence based statements and determine how to strengthen classroom practices.
- Ensure students have mastered foundational skills by using data from NJSLA and other local assessments to determine what supports are needed for each student.
- Ensure students that need assistance have access to Homework Helpers,
 Before School Program, Reading Lab, Math Lab, Summer Support, etc.
- Year 2 of Universal Design for Learning (UDL) teacher training
- Work with LinkIt to examine and evaluate our student intervention systems
- Using the data to inform Title 1 Funding Programming
