

### **ENROLLMENT INFORMATION**

#### 2023-2024 Schedule

The 21stCentury After School program is held every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday during two sessions at the high school level. Students are expected to attend all three days of both sessions. There are no program activities when there is early dismissal from school or during holidays.

- Session #1: Tuesday, October 10, 2023 Thursday, January 25, 2024
- Session #2: Tuesday, February 6, 2024 Thursday, May 23, 2024

## **Daily Schedule**

- 2:10 pm Healthy snacks are provided in the cafeteria.
- 2:20 pm Students work in small groups and receive academic support.
- 3:50 pm Students participate in small group activities such as cooking, sports, and games
- 5:10 pm Students are dismissed. For students needing transportation, a late bus drops students off at the elementary school closest to home.

## **Family Involvement**

## **Enrollment Procedures**

Thanks to grant funding, there are no fees for participation. Enrollment is limited to 40 students. Return of Enrollment Form (pages 3 & 4) does not guarantee participation in 21stCentury After School. Families will be notified by email to confirm their child's enrollment.

- 3. Return the completed Enrollment Form (pages 3 & 4) to the Student Services Office.

## ATTENDANCE AND DISCIPLINE POLICIES

## **Attendance**

Students commit to attending the program for ALL three scheduled days for both sessions. Excessive absences may result in withdrawal.

If a student will be absent, parents/guardians must provide notification by calling and leaving a message or emailing the Director.

Family members are encouraged to attend all family activities and agree to attend at least one family activity during the school year.

## Discipline

All Stratford Board of Education rules and regulations are in effect during all 21stCentury After School activities and on field trips. Cooperation is expected and not following the rules can result in immediate withdrawal. The safety of students is taken seriously. Any instances of serious disturbances such as:

- Fighting
- Bullying
- Threatening
- Possession of substances illegal in school
- Late bus behavior
- Repeated insubordination to a staff member

WILL NOT BE tolerated and may result in immediate withdrawal.

If a student is asked to leave a class or group, the student will sit out the remainder of the period with 21st Century After School staff and the student's parent/guardian is called. If a student is asked to leave more than once during the week, the student will meet with 21stCentury After School staff to discuss continued participation. The parent/guardian will also be called and included in the discussion.

Students assigned to an out-of-school suspension are NOT allowed to participate in 21stCentury After School activities during their suspension. Students assigned to an in-school suspension must meet with the program director and school administration to determine whether they can participate.

Electronic devices such as cell phones may not be used without permission. If a student needs to use the phone to contact a parent/guardian, access is provided to a school phone.
