Keeping Everyone Healthy

Students with cough, sore throat, headache, fever, vomiting or diarrhea, loss of taste and/or smell, extreme fatigue or any other health concerns **should not be at school**. Students who are not feeling well are not prepared to learn. Symptoms must be resolved for 24 hours without the use of pain/fever reducing medications for a full 24 hours before a student returns to school. Reminder—kids sometimes get a little messy at recess!! Please send spare clothes for your kids each day to keep in their cubbies and spare footwear if they come in boots. Remember, as the weather gets cooler, kids need more layers and coats, hats, mittens, etc. We still go outside three times a day when it isn't steadily raining, very windy and the temp is above 10 degrees F.
