Ms. Tibbett's K/1 Classroom

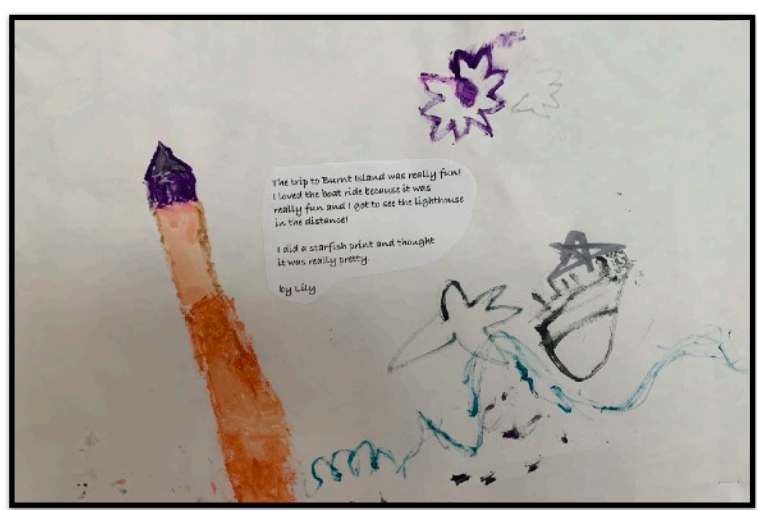
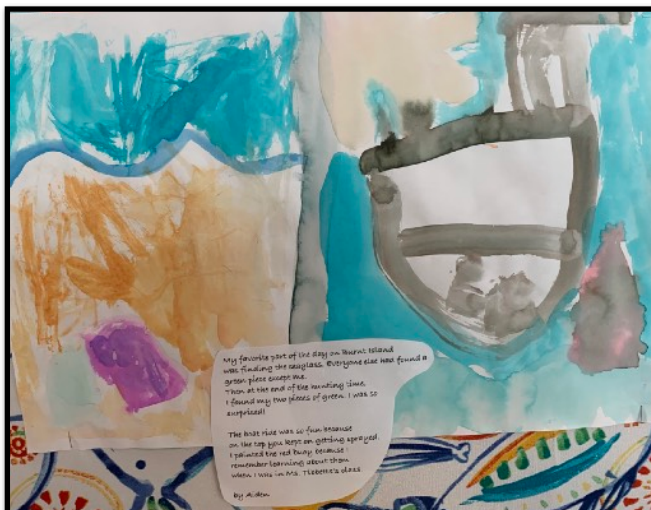
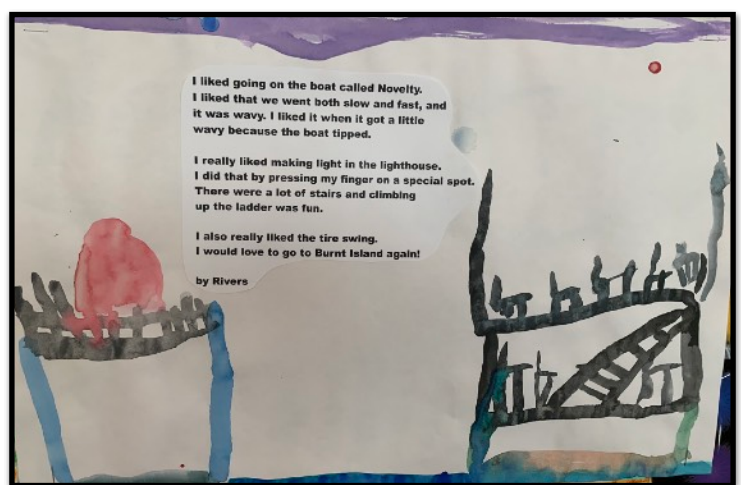
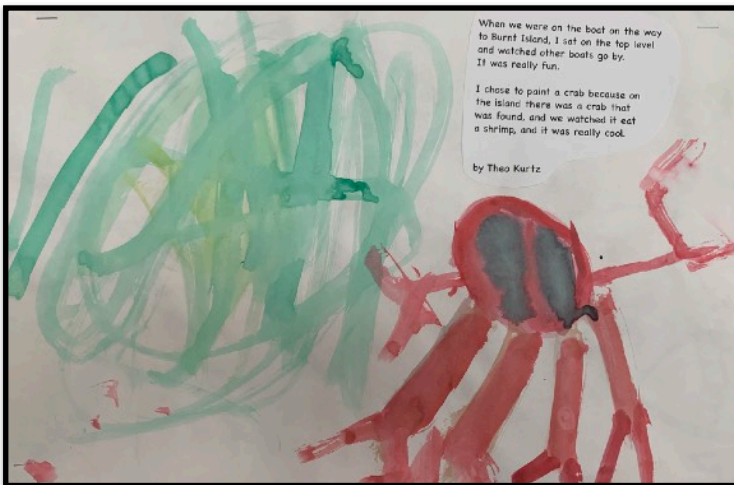
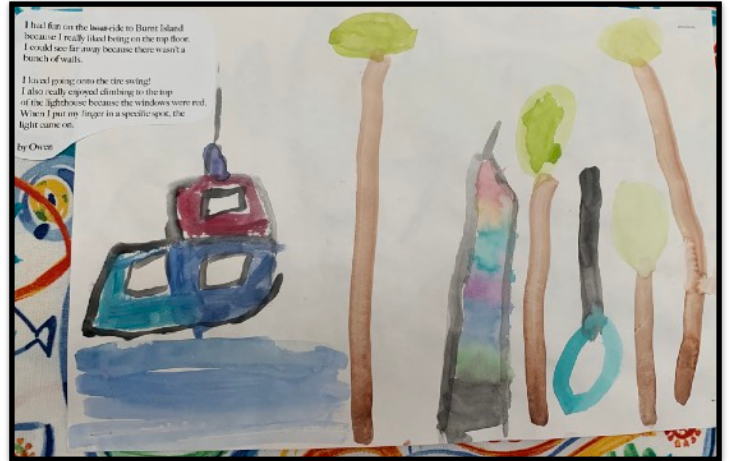
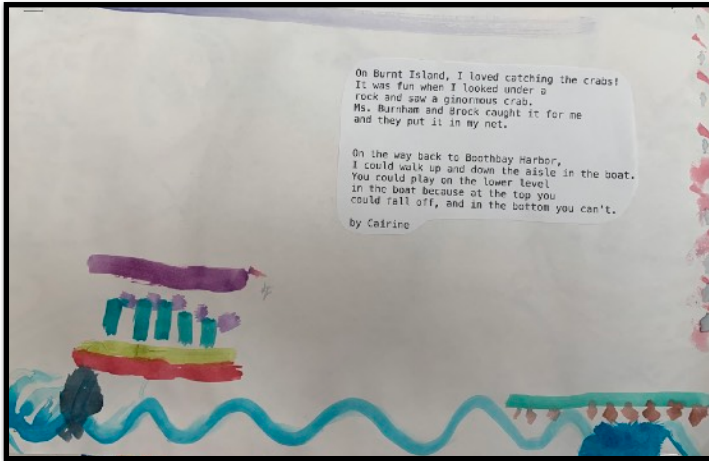

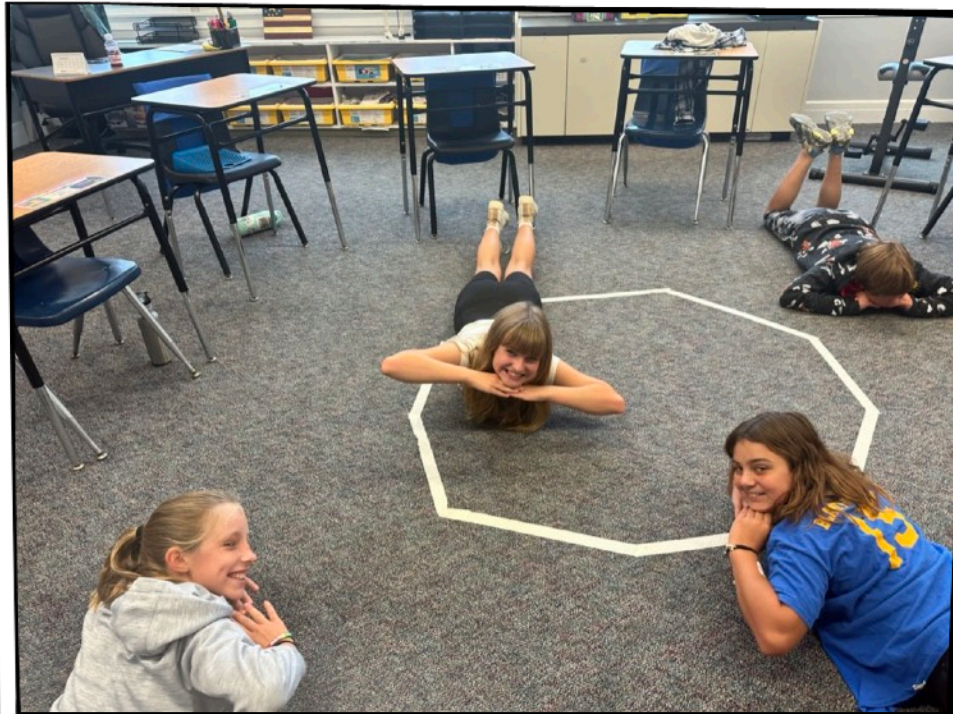


Ms. Clarke's Gr. 2 Classroom
