Second graders are shown working together on floor puzzles and a place value game. We're off to a great start...it's going to be an awesome year!










#### Mrs. Browne's 4-6 Classroom

Friday, we took a walk to the beach and worked on creative writing pieces related to the ocean!














The children love playing in the mud behind the school; they just need to wear rubber boots. Please consider sending in rubber boots and a change of clothes... just in case.
