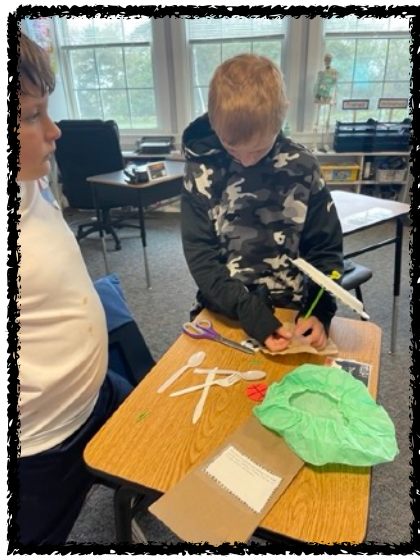
Oct. 3rd, Flu shot clinic(1:00-2:00 PM) - send in your paperwork

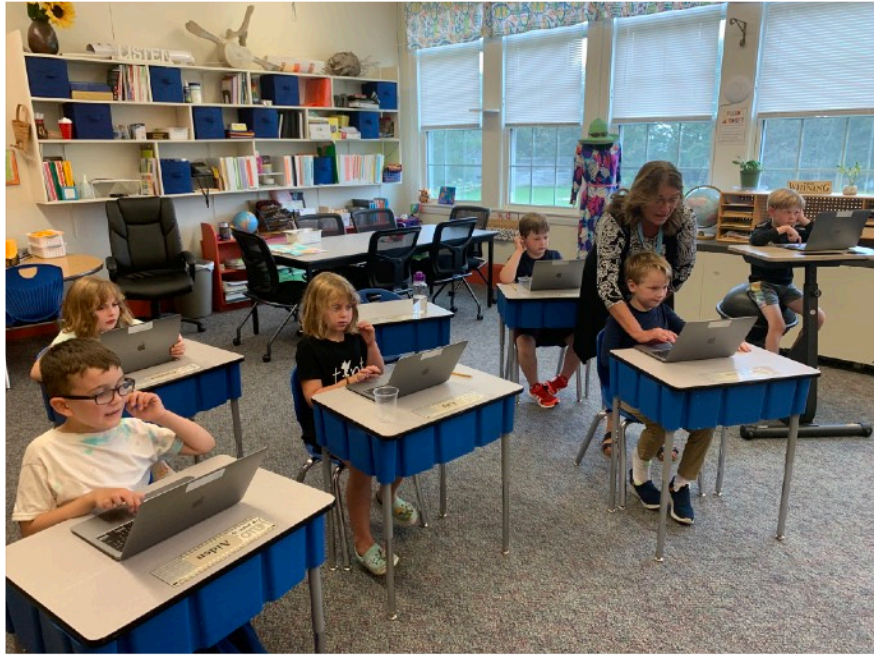
Ms. Tibbett's K/1 Classroom

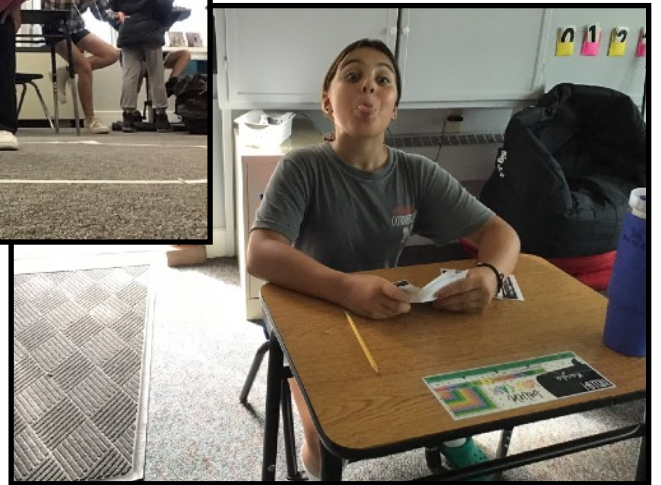
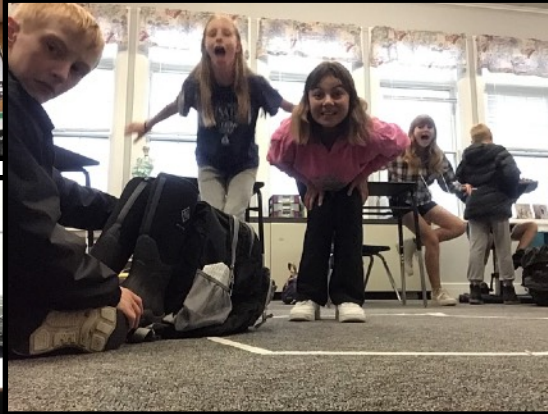
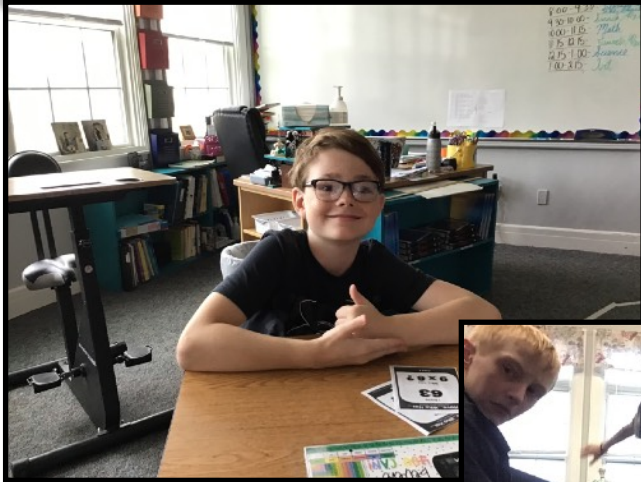
Ms. Clarke's 3/4 Classroom
