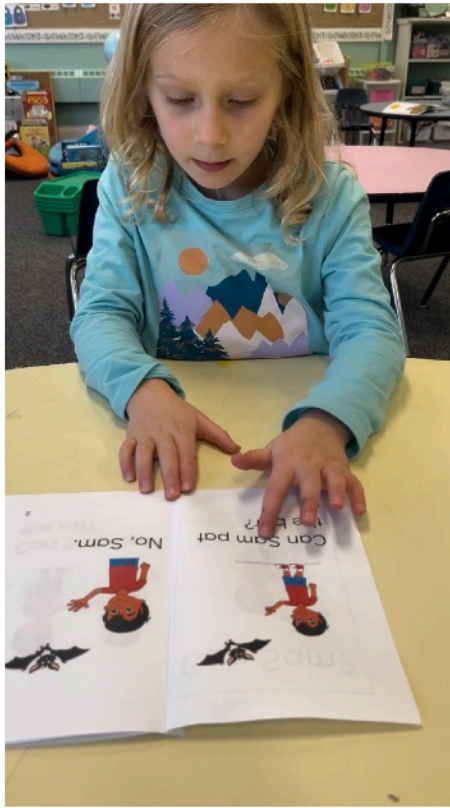

We also have been practicing adding detail to our illustrations and drawing our favorite parts of the stories we read. I'm so proud of them!

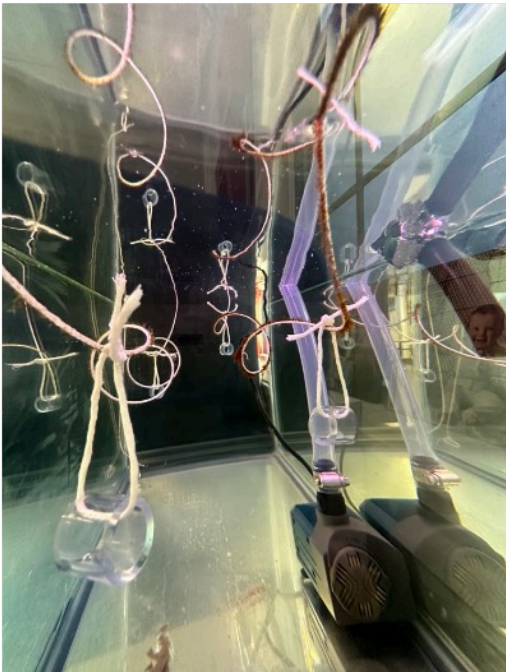


MS. CLARKE'S GRADE 2 CLASSROOM
