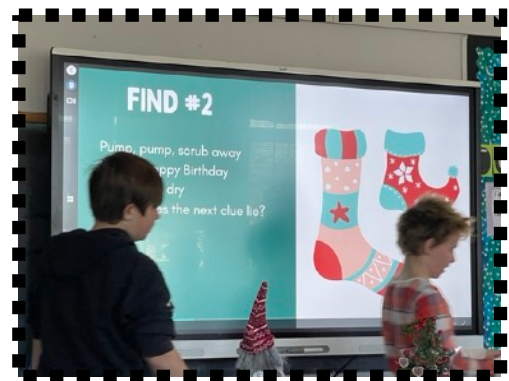
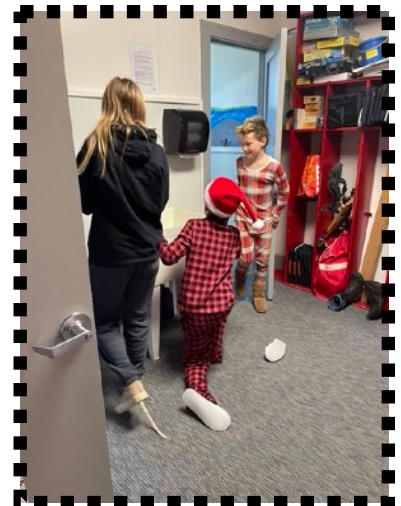


MRS. BROWNE'S GRADE 4/5/6 CLASSROOM
