



COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROVISION

Dear parents and guardians,

We are pleased to inform you that Klamath Falls City Schools has implemented an option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for School Year 2023-2024.

What does this mean for you and your children? Great news for you and your children!

All enrolled students of Klamath Falls City Schools are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2023–2024 school year. No further action is required of you. Your children will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay for meals or submit an application.

If your children attend schools that are not participating in CEP, your household may still need to fill out a confidential meal application or pay for meals.
