Parental Involvement

In order to assure collaborative relationships between students' families, the community, and the District, and to enable parents/guardians to become active partners in their children's education, the Superintendent shall:

- 1. Keep parents/guardians thoroughly informed about their child's school and education.
- 2. Encourage parents/guardians/community to be involved in their child's school and education.
- 3. Establish effective two-way communication between parents/guardians and the District.
- 4. Seek the advice of parents/guardians/community on school governance issues and methods to fulfill the District's educational mission.
- 5. Inform parents/guardians on how they can assist in their children's learning.

The Superintendent shall periodically report to the School Board on the implementation of this policy.
