SAFETY REPORT – Mr. Maes

The Raptor System is currently in use across all school sites, including the District Office and the BHS guard shack. Mr. Maes presented the Board with a summary of visitor and contractor sign-ins by school site from 8/22/24 to 9/25/24. Ms. Chavez raised concerns about the high number of students being checked out or arriving late, questioning why parents are frequently visiting schools and expressing worry about potential disruptions to student learning.

Mr. Maes informed the Board that he will collaborate with Rave and Raptor on reunification plans for all school sites. Additionally, the district is transitioning to the Verkada Security System, which will enhance camera quality and provide key card access. The implementation of these projects will be site-specific.
