BPS – IED NEWS AND UPDATES

- Federal Grants – Title IV and Title VII Impact aid due end of January.
- State Grants – Approved for \$174,338 for the 24-25 SY. Had a carryover of \$159,306 from last year.
- Tribal Education Status Report – TESR is in process and waiting on a few more reports from administration.
- Tribal Leadership Summit – Summit will take place at SLA on November 14 and 15.
- Needs Assessment – Assessments will begin in the spring of next year for staff and students. Indian Education will be working on creating initiatives for community engagement to tie into a Native American Strategic Plan
- Cultural Competency Framework – We continue to work on the framework.

- BHS tutoring – BHS is seeking tutors to help with tutoring for the remaining school year.
