Air Monitoring Network

CCAC, in partnership with Los Banos Unified School District, deployed a network of air pollution monitors at schools across the district. This includes 10 monitors and 1 regulatory grade monitor.

This project is funded by the California Air Resources Board.



Goal of this project

Our goal is to educate residents about air pollution and how to protect vulnerable communities. This involves setting up a Community Steering Committee and utilizing, the SJVAir alert system.



Community Steering Committee

Establishing a Community Steering Committee to help inform school staff and residents about air pollution, SJVAir and how to protect vulnerable populations (kids, elderly)



SJVAir

SJVAir provides email and text message alerts to schools and residents based on *local*, real-time PM2.5 data from the monitors nearest your school, home or work

- 2. Subscribe to monitors: Sign up to receive alerts from any of the 400+ monitors in the SJVAir network
- Select Alert Level: choose your preferred air quality level (e.g. unhealthy for sensitive individuals). You can change alert levels anytime.
