The mission of Hoxie School District is to promote a culture of lifelong learning, in which all students excel, in a safe environment that values and respects diversity where students are vested in their future.



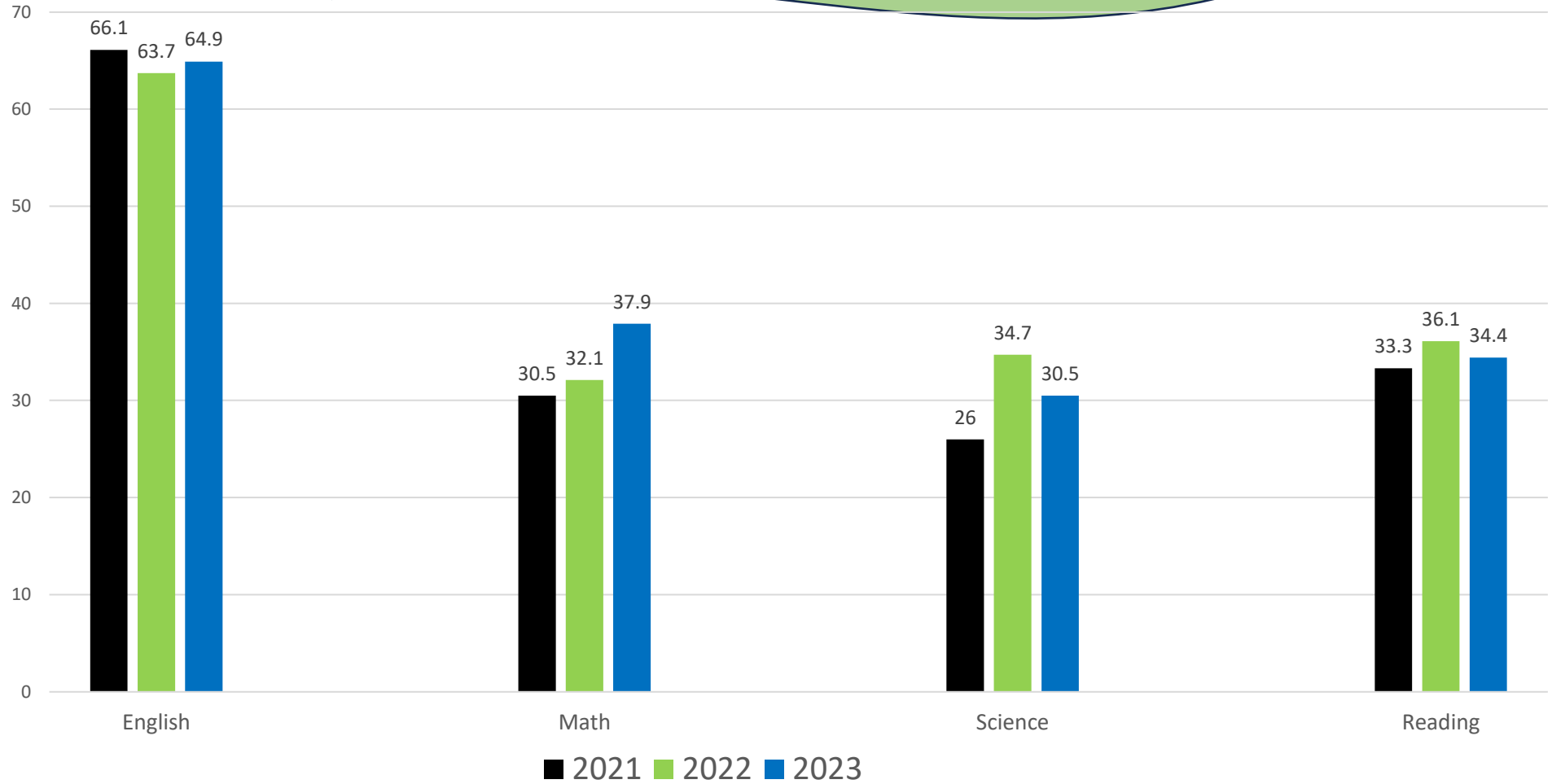

Grades 3 through 10



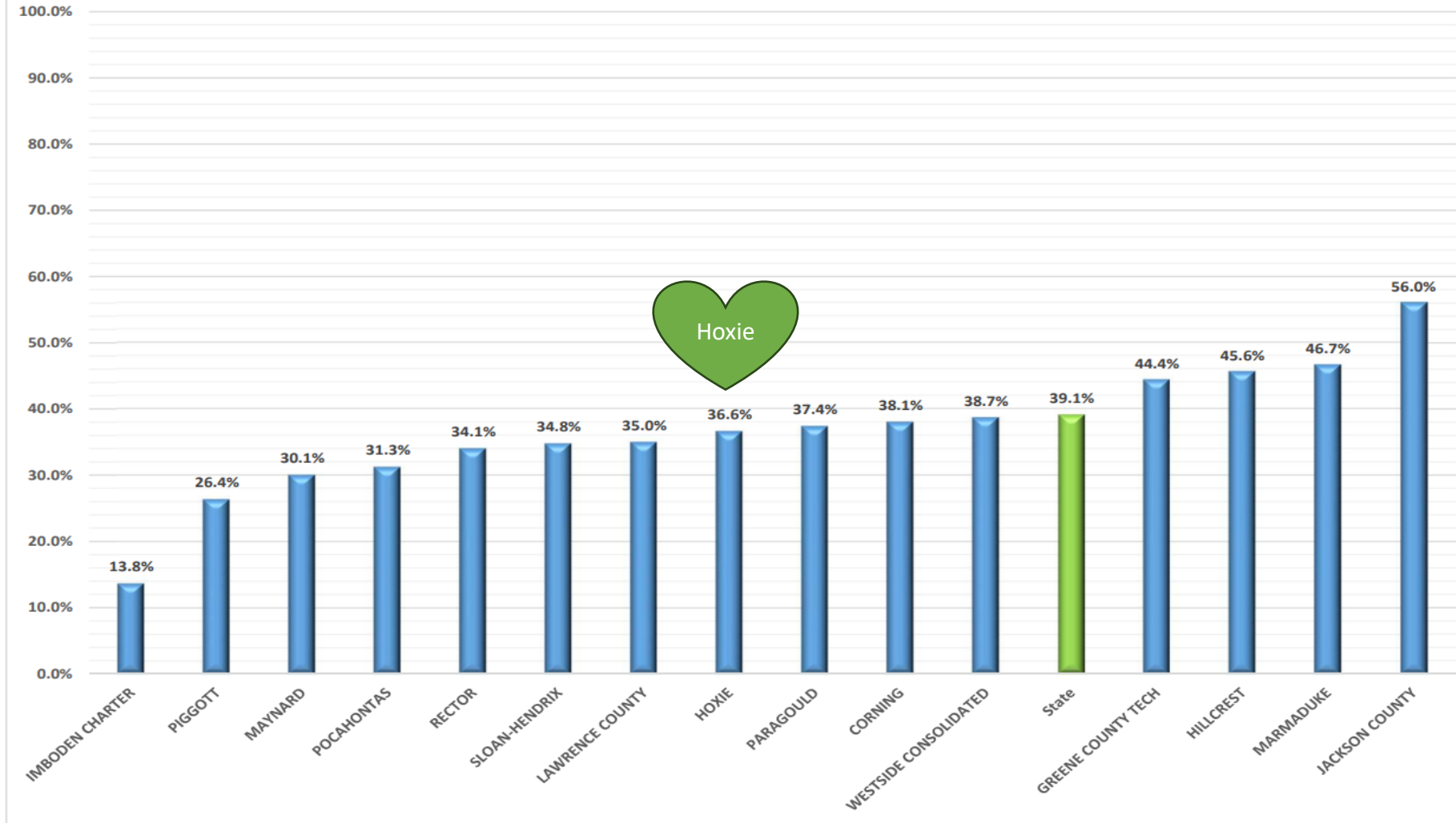

Parts of a Plant

FLOWERS

attract pollinators and make seeds that will someday grow into new plants



The part of the flower that holds the seed is called the ovary. After pollination, the petals fall away and the ovary develops into a **FRUIT**. The fruit protects the developing seeds.

LEAVES

are food factories. Leaves have little openings that let air and water come and go. Leaves catch energy from sunlight and use it to turn the air and water into food.

SEEDS

are little cases with a baby plant inside. The parent plant packs the seed with nutrition, just like a lunch. Seeds end up having much more energy than other parts of the plant.

THE STEM

supports the plant and carries water, nutrients and plant chemicals up and down to all parts of the plant.



ROOTS

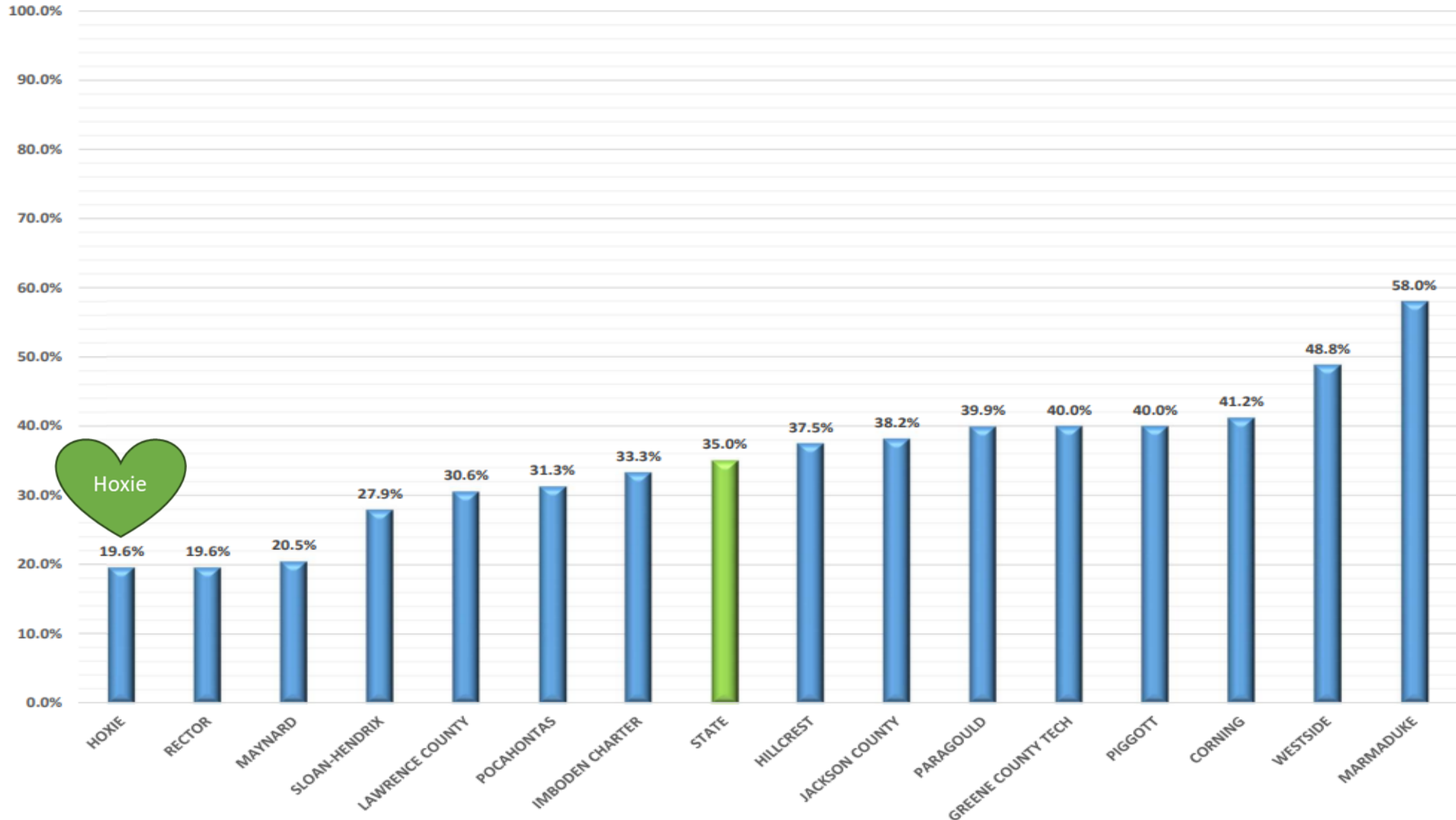
are hidden underground but are very important to the plant. Roots hold the plant steady in the ground, suck up water and nutrients from the soil and even store food for the future.

Hoxie Schools ACT Aspire State, School, & Goal Comparison Percent Meeting or Exceeding Readiness Benchmark

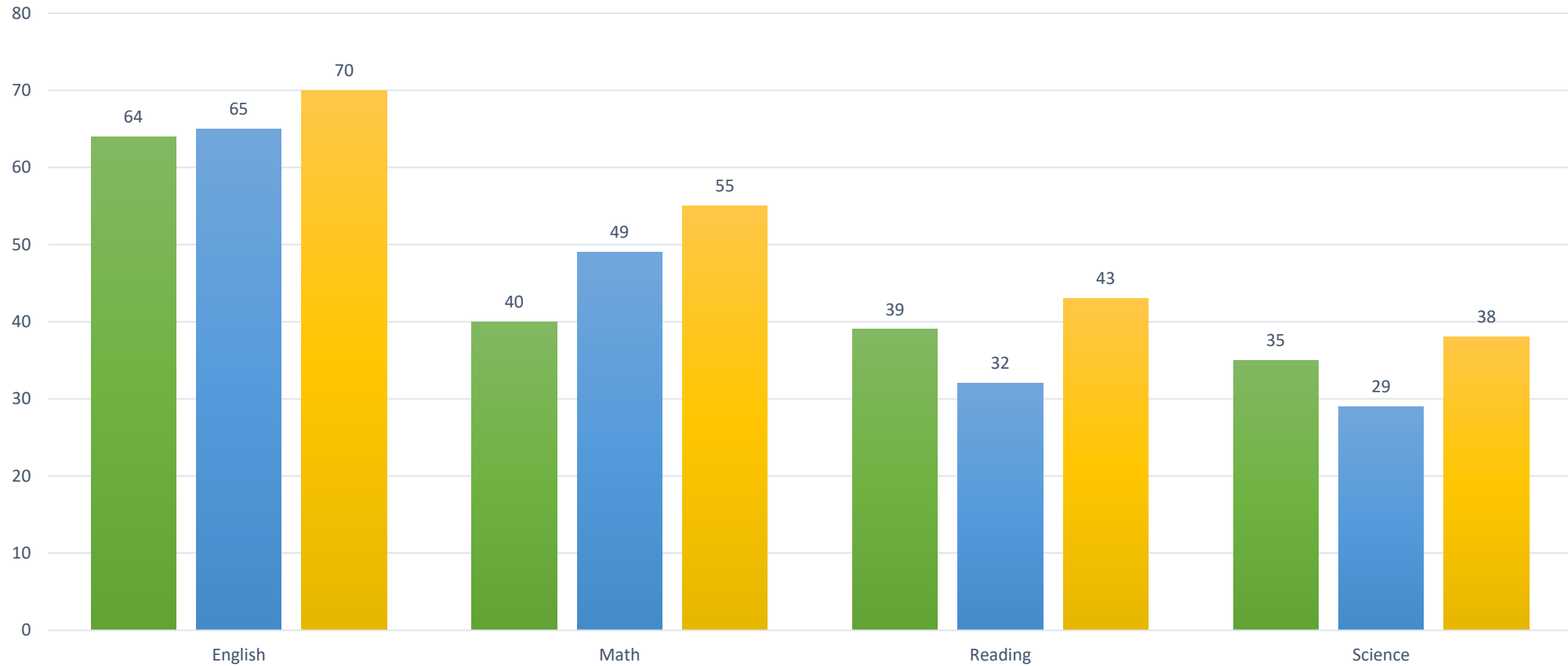

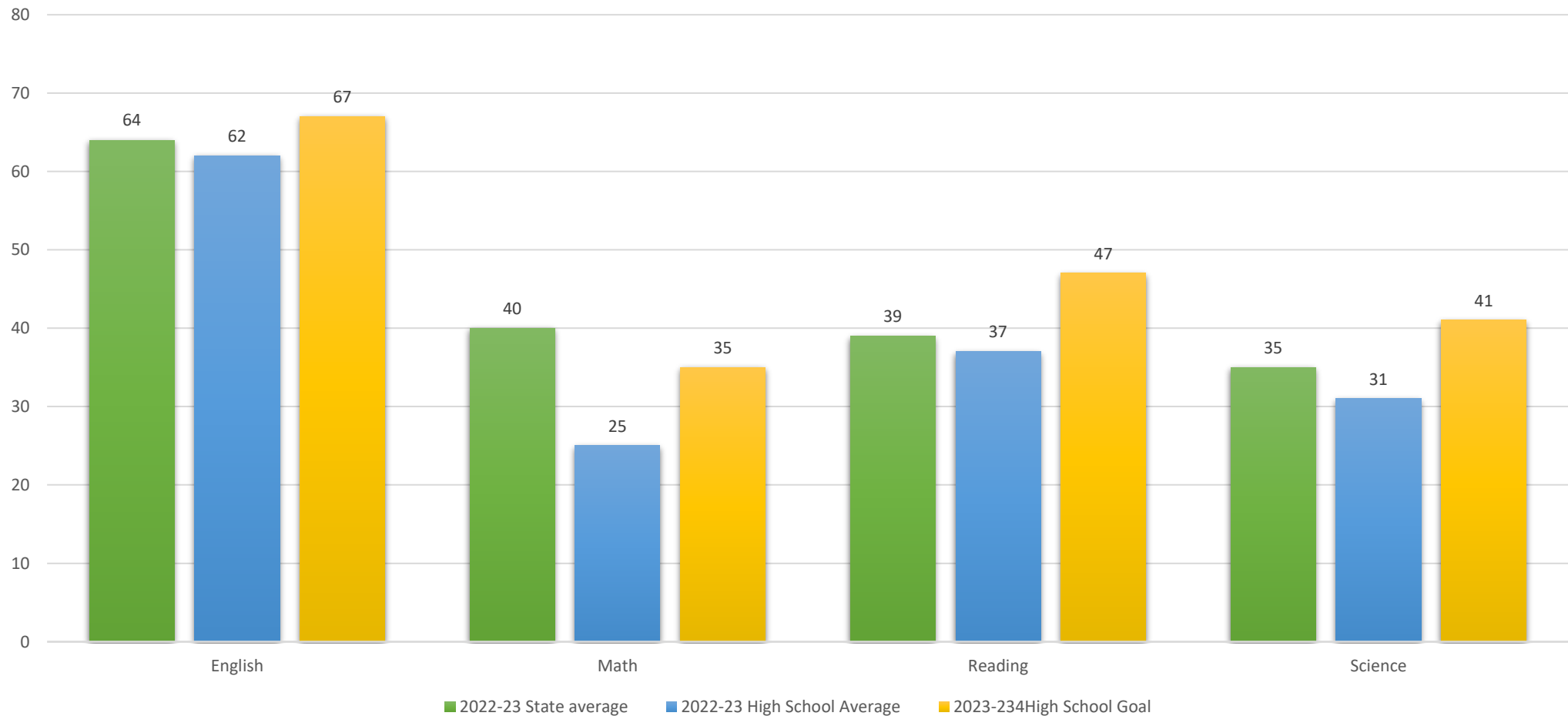

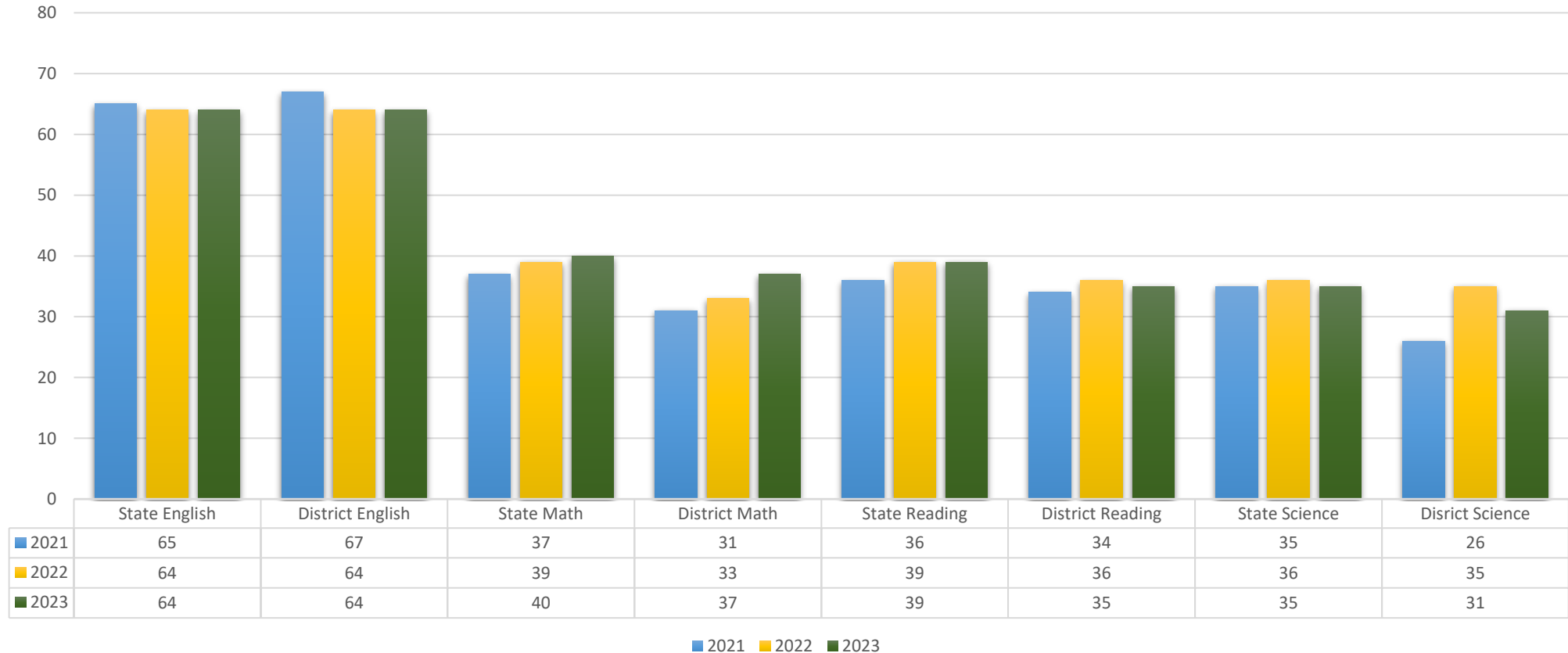

Assessment Updates

Grades K-2

- Continue Renaissance Star Assessments in math and literacy
 - Administered at least three times throughout the year to monitor student learning and help drive instruction
 - Immediate feedback for teachers and interventionist.
 - Teachers and students set Literacy and Math goals in STAR each 9 weeks.
 - ATLAS Class Tools – Common Formative Assessments – check points for instruction.

Grades 3-11

- Continue Renaissance Star Assessments in math and literacy to help drive instruction
 - Administered at least three times during the year
 - Progress monitor assessment monthly to track progress.
 - Provide real-time data to help drive instruction focusing on individual student needs
 - Immediate feedback for teachers
- ATLAS 3-10
 - Science interims open in October 2023.
 - Summative is administered in the spring
 - Receive results in the summer
 - ATLAS Class Tools – Common Formative Assessments – check points for instruction.

The ATLAS end-of-year summative assessment will be used to assess all Arkansas public school students in grades 3-8 in the content areas of English Language Arts (ELA), mathematics, and science. Students will take end of year exams for ELA in grades 9 and 10 and end of course exams for algebra I, geometry, and biology. Algebra I may be taken in eighth grade and replace the eighth grade mathematics assessment if a student is enrolled in algebra I at that time. All students will be required to participate in ATLAS 3-10 summative unless they qualify for an alternate assessment. The first administration will occur in spring 2024 and is aligned to the [Arkansas standards](#).

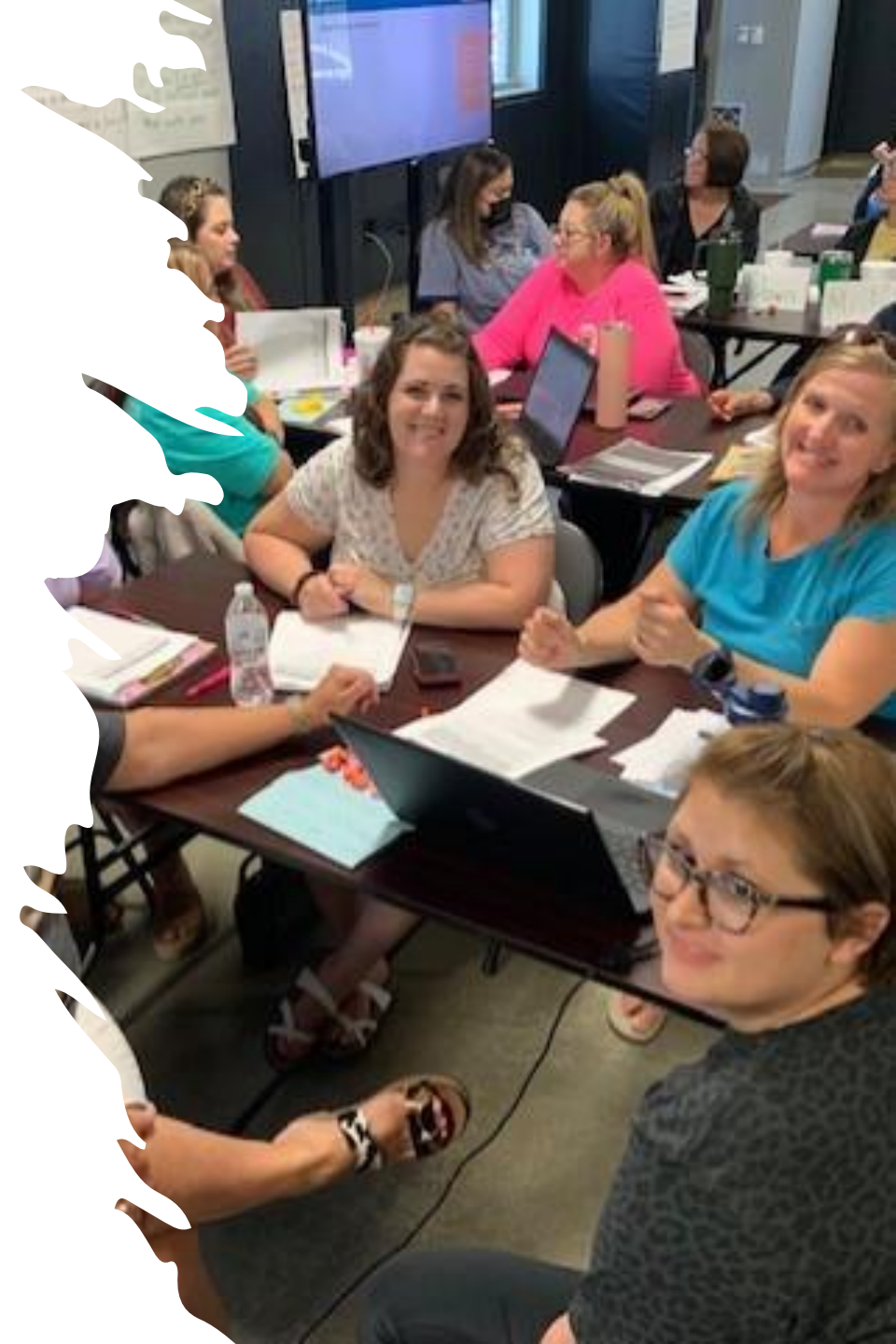
Accelerated Learning Plan for closing the Achievement Gap!

- In response to the achievement gap, teachers have:
 - Identified the essential standards for each core subject area in each grade level and the prerequisite for each standard.
 - Analyzed each identified standard for support and additional supplement
 - Developed a student-friendly learning objective and added Success criteria to match the lesson.
 - Created a pacing guide to accelerate learning.
 - Lesson plans are placed in a central location for each administrator.
 - Elementary's plans are in a shared Lesson Plan Hub where teachers set goals for each standard.
 - High school's plans are in a digital shared folder, monitored by the principal.



NIET Partnership continues.

- Grant through the Arkansas Rural Educator Network to support educators through district partnerships to provide in-depth support
 - Funded by the Walton Family Foundations totaling close to \$200,000 over 3 years
 - Extended to 4 years
- NIET conducted a strengths-based needs assessment and collaboratively developed a support plan with the district leaders
- NIET will work alongside the district team to continually monitor, reflect, and adjust support as needed
- Effective Professional Learning Committees (PLCs) will be implemented through facilitated support from NIET

Identifying Essential Standards– teachers across the district worked together to identify the Essential standards in English Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies.

Lesson Planning- Teachers across the district met to collaboratively complete lesson plans with the help of the standards document used to identify Essential Standards. These lesson plans are shared with Principals. Lesson plans contain objectives, student success criteria, assessments and results along with the date of completion.

Curriculum Alignment- Teachers in Elementary were able to discuss essential standards in each subject area and align skills to be progressing towards mastery. High School teachers were able to work in subject and grade bands to discuss when essential standards were addressed and to what depth they were assessed. End of Course assessment was a focus area along with grading, parent expectation and HQIM.

FLVS – Hoxie Online Academy teachers were trained on using the Florida Virtual School curriculum to provide instruction for our online students

Family and Community Engagement–Elementary teachers met and discussed Parent night activities for each month through out the school year. High School teachers have discussed planning a meeting to help the new Parent and Family Engagement coordinator to plan events for parents to attend during the schoolyear.

Universal Design for Learning (UDL)– Teachers examined the purpose of UDL knowledge and the application of high-quality classroom instruction for all students, including students with disabilities

Response to Intervention- Teachers examined the purpose behind intervention, Science of Reading, CKLA resources and 95% group intervention materials. Assessment data, progress monitoring and screening expectations were set by the principal in Elementary. RTI purpose, scheduling and expectations were set by the High School principal.

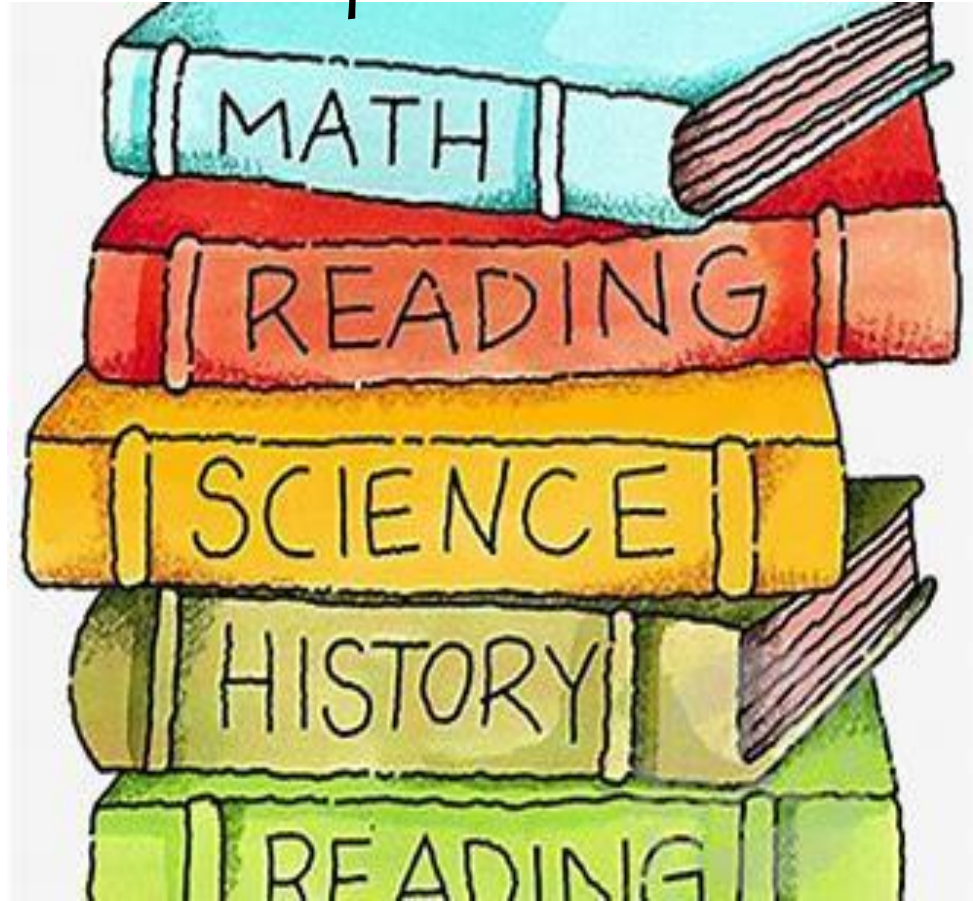

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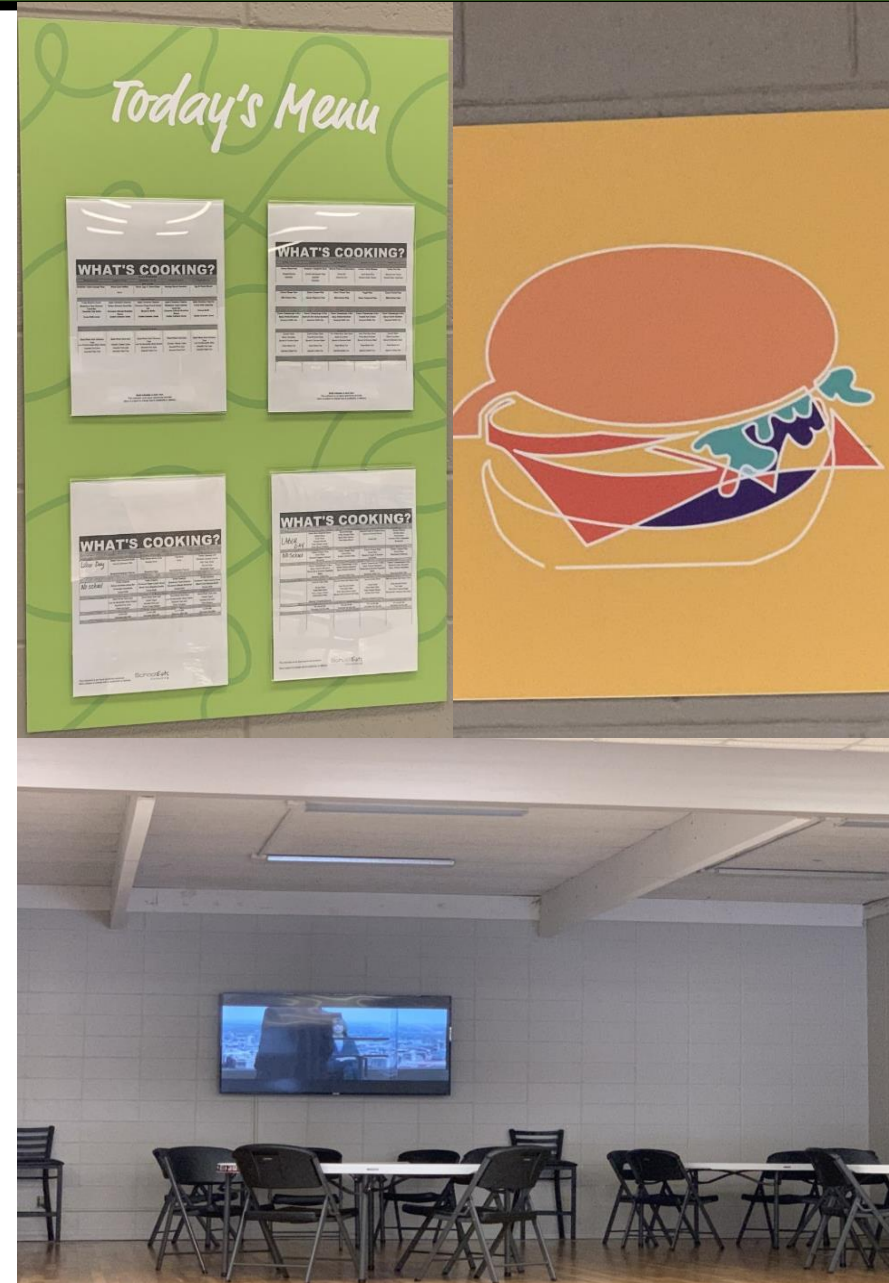

Lunchroom Updates

- COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROVISION (CEP)
 - Continue to provide **ALL** students meals (breakfast and lunch) at **NO CHARGE**
 - Funded through United States Dept. of Agriculture (USDA) Special Assistance Certification and Reimbursement Community Eligibility Provision
- Many food options for students including nacho bar, hamburgers, pizza, salads and homestyle meals.
- K- 12 grade students are provided a free afternoon snack by Life 360.



Facilities and Maintenance Updates Summer 2023

- CO-OP grant funds were used to complete the Pre-K Playground with new fencing, sun sails and a trike path.
- CO-OP grant funds were also used to remove asbestos tile and old lighting from the Pre-K classrooms.
- Removed asbestos in several High School classrooms.
- Remodeled 2 High School Science Labs.
- The process for adding a Buzz in security system is currently being installed.
- Replaced several exterior doors with safety doors.
- Replaced damaged HVAC units for the mustang gym and cafeteria kitchen.
