GOAL 1: The school will work with families to build strong communication.

This goal will be promoted by:

- Teachers will remain in contact with families to keep open communication.
- Teachers, staff, and administrators will provide timely information about school programs and scholars within a 48-hour time period.
- Campus family engagement events will be held on different nights/days to avoid schedule conflicts with other BISD campuses and to fit family schedules better.
- The campus will use social media, parent link phone calls, and notices from classroom teachers, in the student's native language, regarding campus events/news and the student's progress in school.

GOAL 2: The school will strive to embrace all.

This goal will be promoted by:

- The Davila Foundations Committee will continue to address and evaluate innovative
 ways to communicate with students and their families. Information will be provided to
 families on the importance of being actively involved in their student's education and
 campus volunteer opportunities.
- The committee will involve parents in the planning, reviewing, and improving programs, such as the School, Parent, and Family Engagement Policy and the joint development of the schoolwide campus plan.
- The Campus will remain open to ideas from all families regarding community and family involvement, including adequate representation of family demographics concerning the schoolwide campus plan. Parents can contact the school with ideas by phone, email, or personal contact as needed.

GOAL 3: Parent education opportunities will be provided.

This goal will be promoted by:

- Resources will be provided on how to contact campus, district, and community with ongoing opportunities for academic recovery and growth which will provide support for families in need of academic assistance.
- Training parents to use Home Access Center (HAC) in order to monitor student's grades from home at any time.
- Providing assistance to parents in understanding State academic standards and academic assessments, plus working with educators to improve achievement.
- Providing support for parent involvement activities as requested.

GOAL 4: The school will strive to make parent connections with academically unengaged families.

This goal will be promoted by:

- Community/ school liaisons will make multiple efforts to develop relationships with students and their families.
- The campus will actively recruit volunteers and members for PTO.
- Educating teachers, specialized instructional support personnel, principals, other school leaders, and other staff, with the assistance of parents, in the value and utility of contributions of parents and in how to reach out to, communicate with, and work with parents as equal partners, implement and coordinate parent programs, and build ties between parents and the school

EVALUATION:

The Davila Middle School Family Engagement Policy will be evaluated and updated each year by the Campus Foundations Team, which is composed of parents, teachers, students, and community members. Additionally, an annual meeting will be held where the policy will be reviewed. Also shared will be a review of the campus accountability information.
